Steiner also won major tag team titles in the U.S. and Japan. When he went solo, he amassed three WCW Television titles and one WCW U.S. Championship.

As WCW Rookie of the Year, Bagwell started his career strong. His impressive resume includes four WCW World Tag Team titles and a boxing match against Rowdy Roddy Piper, with Judge Mills Lane as guest referee.

Bagwell combines a unique blend of power and quickness when delivering his signature move, the Buff Blockbuster.
