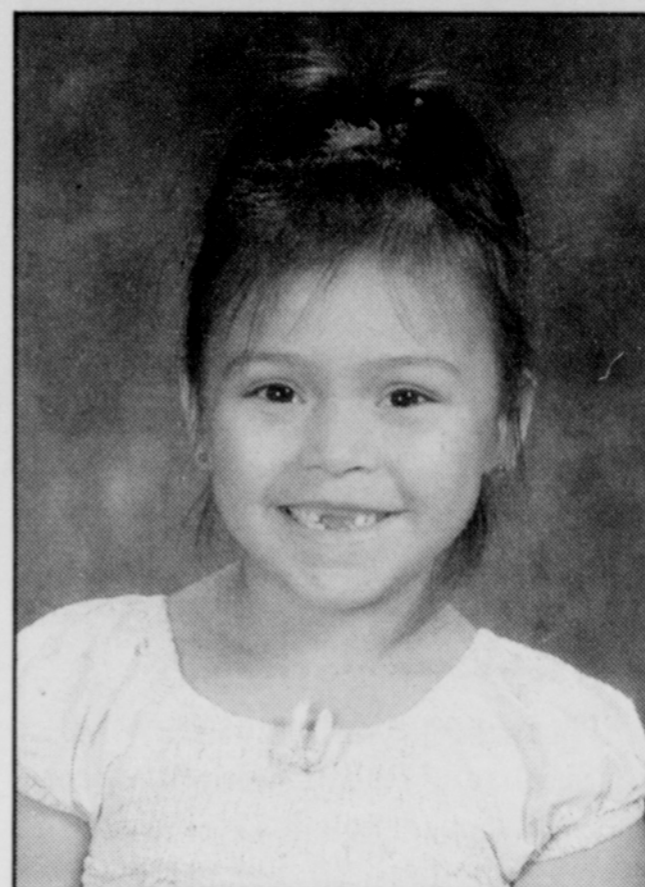
Amy Nicole Brown

Amy was awarded Senior of the Year for Physical Education. She played varsity soccer for Mountain View and they took district champs for 2004.

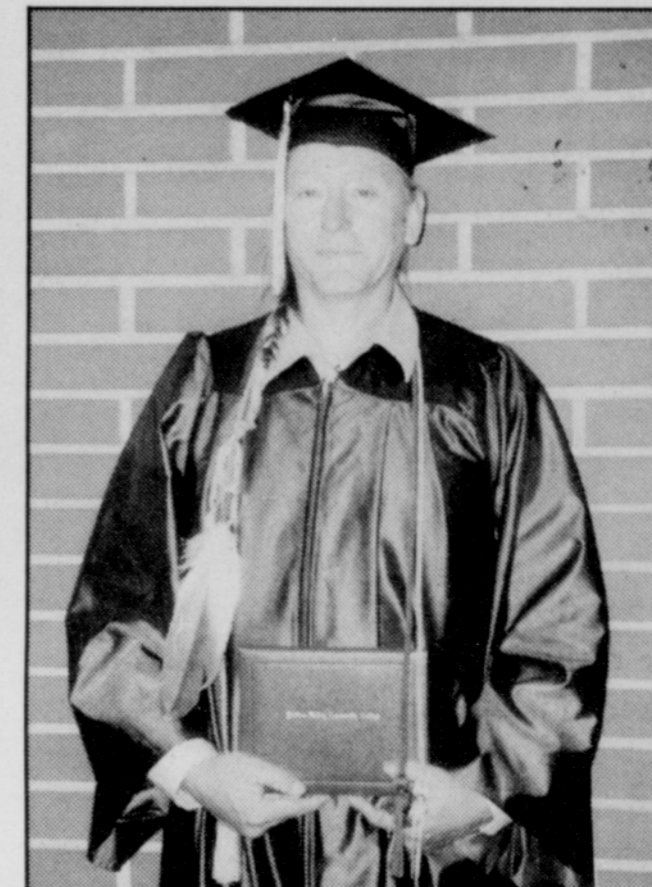


Jazmyn Metcalf

Way to go! Keep up the good work!



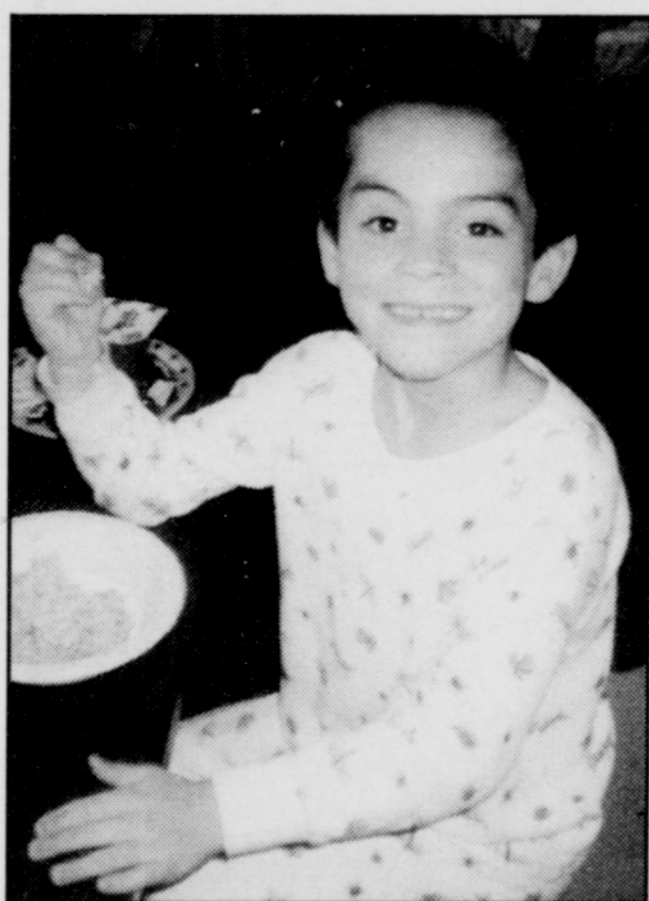
Stuart Whitehead
