Carvers Return for Show and Sale

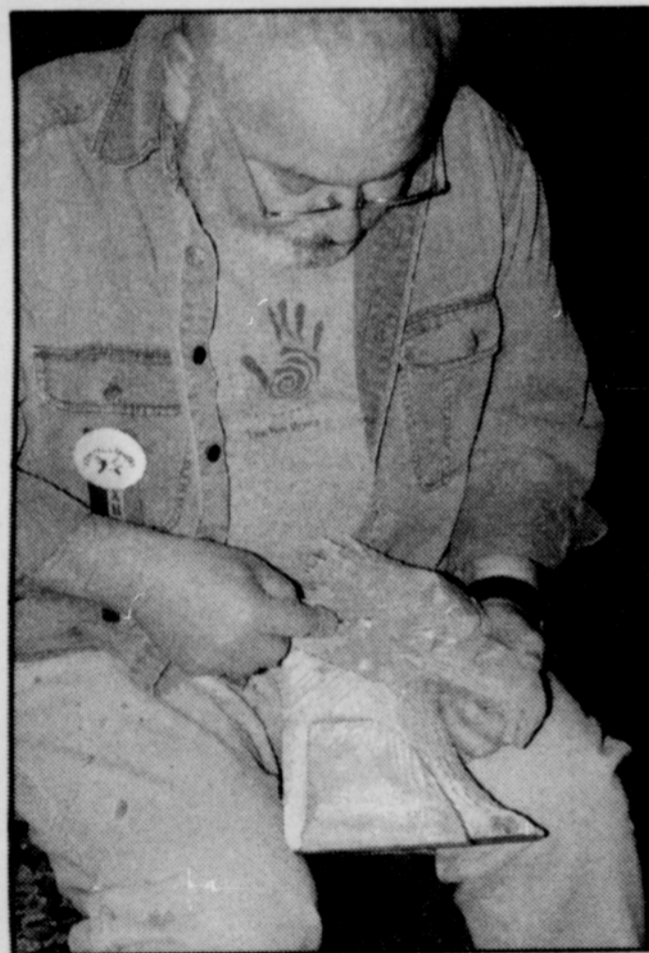
The 13th Annual Coastal Carvers Show and Sale will be held at Chinook Winds Casino Resort on Jan. 15-16.

Demonstrations for children and adult carvers will teach the aspiring artists, as well lovers of the art. For those interested in taking up carving or replenishing their carving tool sets, supplies also will be available for sale.

Jerry Simchuk, an accomplished caricature wood carver, is this year's featured artist. In just 10 years of competing in wood carving competitions, Simchuk has placed in some of the most prestigious contests, including the Ward World Championships, where he also has participated as a judge.

The 13th Annual Coastal Carvers Show and Sale is an all-ages event that is open to the public and free of charge. Hours are 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Jan. 15 and 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Jan. 16.

Smokey Robinson Returns with Motown Sound

Chinook Winds Casino Resort welcomes back Rock 'n' Roll Hall of Fame star Smokey Robinson on Jan. 14-15. His emotion-filled lyrics have composed some of the most romantic pop songs in past decades.

William "Smokey" Robinson's high tenor calling card is internationally known, but he's also recognized as one of the most important songwriters and producers of the 1960s. The only Motown artist to write and produce his own recordings from the beginning, he also wrote and produced many of the




most memorable songs for Motown's other acts, including *Ain't That Peculiar* for Marvin Gaye, *My Guy* for Mary Wells, and *My Girl* and *Get Ready* for The Temptations.

Robinson kept plenty of top material for himself, from early hits like *Shop Around*, *You Really Got a Hold on Me* and *Ooh Baby, Baby* to timeless classics like *The Tracks of My Tears* and *The Tears of a Clown*. Bob Dylan once called Robinson America's greatest living poet.

Show time for Smokey Robinson is 8 p.m. Tickets range from \$35 to \$55.
