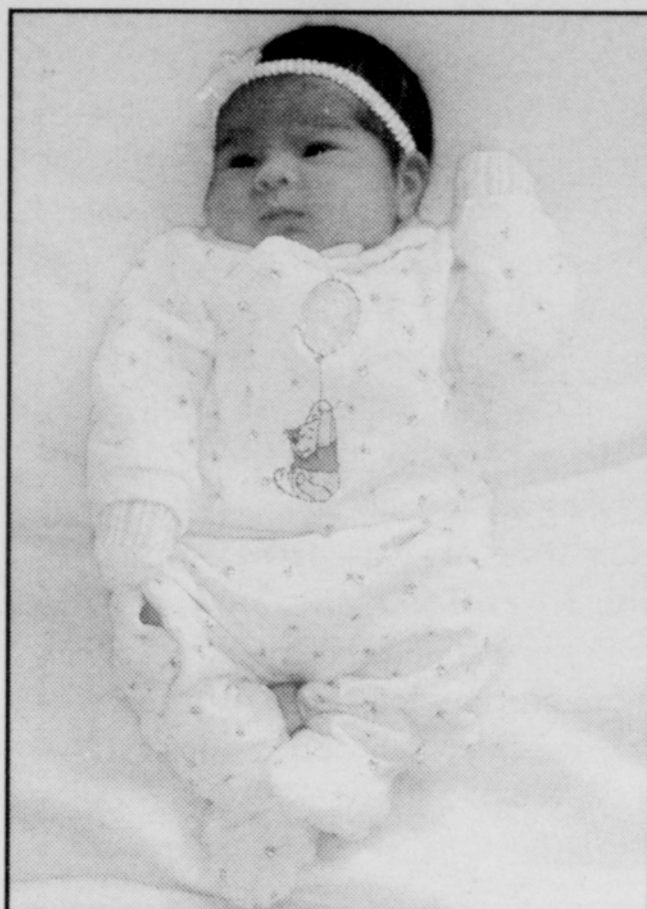

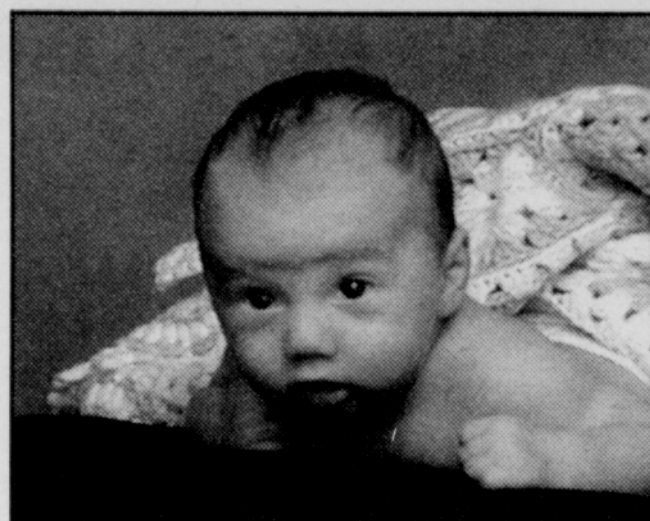


Jasmin Aurilla Trapala-Russell

We love you, Aiden, and are very honored to have you as part of our family.

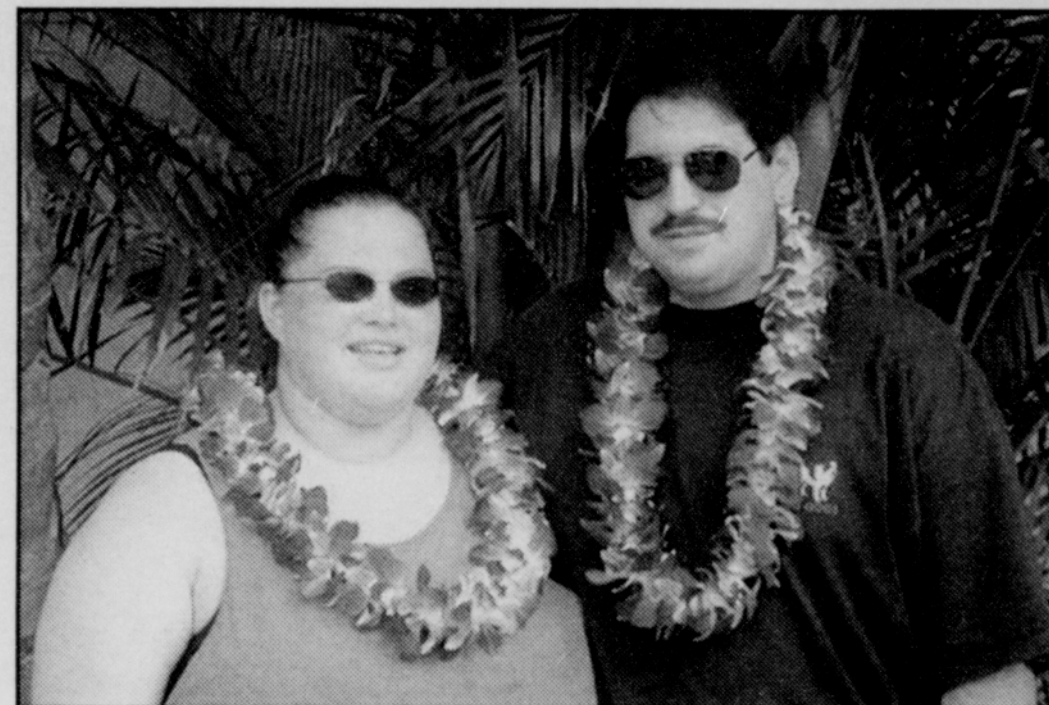
SVS Seeks Substitutes
