Anderson has accomplished something few comedians can attest to — he's funny without being offensive. He began his career at a weekly comedy showcase in Portland, Ore. Soon he was performing at comedy clubs and colleges across the country.

In 1986, he was asked to appear on the *CBS Morning Show*. It was enough

to convince a producer at rival NBC that Anderson was funny. Two weeks later, he was hired as a staff comedy writer for NBC's comedy game show *Wordplay*.

Soon he was busy appearing on such television shows as *An Evening At The Improv*, Fox's *Comedy Express*, and VH-1's *Stand-up Spotlight*. He currently is a contributing writer for *The Tonight Show With Jay Leno* and co-host of the "Show" on 1190 KEX.

Since being named New York's funniest cop (a title he won in 1994), DiResta has had two television shows (*Trash To Cash, DiResta*) and can be seen in *How To Lose A Guy in 10 Days* and *Miss Congeniality*. He appeared

with Robert DeNiro in *15 Minutes* and will return to the big screen in *Miss Congeniality Two*.

DiResta's television appearances include *The Tonight Show With Jay Leno* and *Politically Incorrect*, as well as being a guest on the infamous *Howard Stern Show*.

A regular at Harvey's Comedy Club in Portland, Linde has been seen on Showtime's *Comedy Club Network* and is half of the team that created *Dumped And Divorced*, a two-man show sold out for several weeks.
