July 29-31, 2005

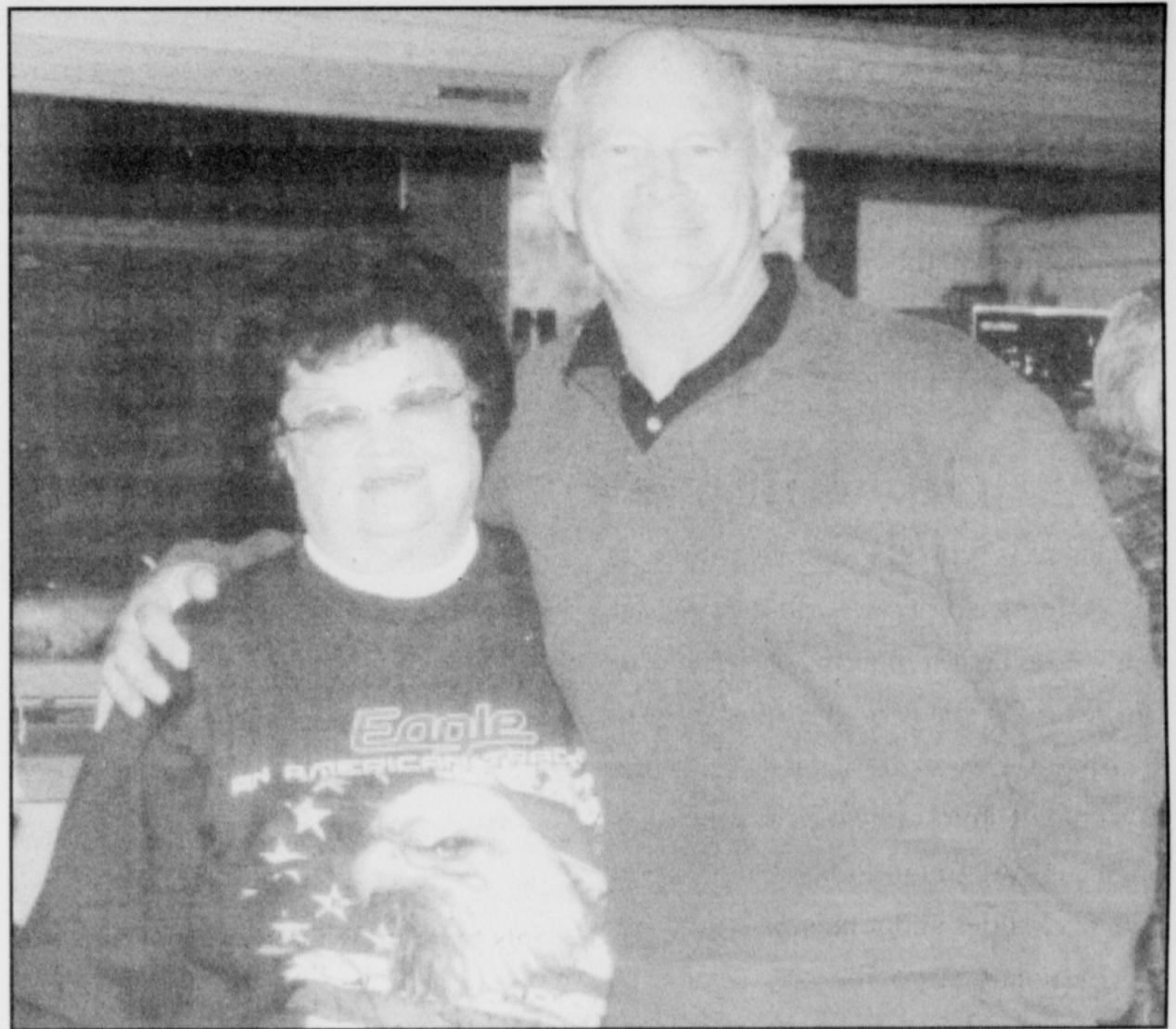
Held at Siletz Nation
