Ga-Young Kim Wins 9-Ball Championship

Ga-Young Kim earned the national title in women's billiards in November at Chinook Winds Casino Resort.

Kim, No. 3 in the world, had to beat both No. 1-ranked Allison Fisher and No. 4-ranked Monica Webb in the semis to make it to the finals. There she battled No 9-ranked Vivian "Texas Tornado" Villarreal before winning the Cuetec Cues National 9-Ball Championships.

Fans were not disappointed as Villarreal took on Korea's No. 1 player, Kim. Villarreal went into the finals undefeated in the tournament and awaited her eventual opponent as Kim took on England's Fisher.

In the race to seven games, Kim outplayed Fisher 7 to 5 and then defeated Webb 7-4. The tension was high as the

final match between Villarreal and Kim was set.

An American national titleholder was a possibility once again as Villarreal battled hard against one of the hottest players on tour and the reigning Cuetec Cues U.S. Open champion.

The match came to a head at 6-6, with the crowd intent on every play. The break went to Villarreal in the final game. After a tough break, Kim ran out the rack for the match and the title.

The Women's Professional Billiards Association is 29 years old and is the sport's oldest professional player organization. In a sport where billiard clubs were only recently known as the last bastion of male dominance, pool now makes its mark as one of the few sports where the women pros are leading the way.

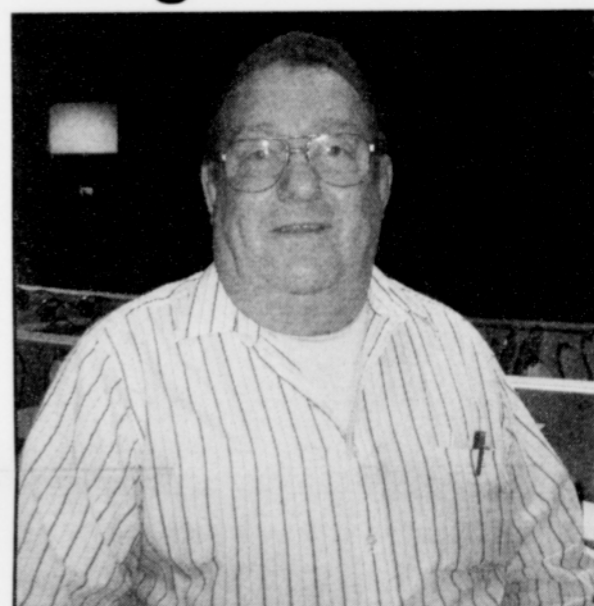
