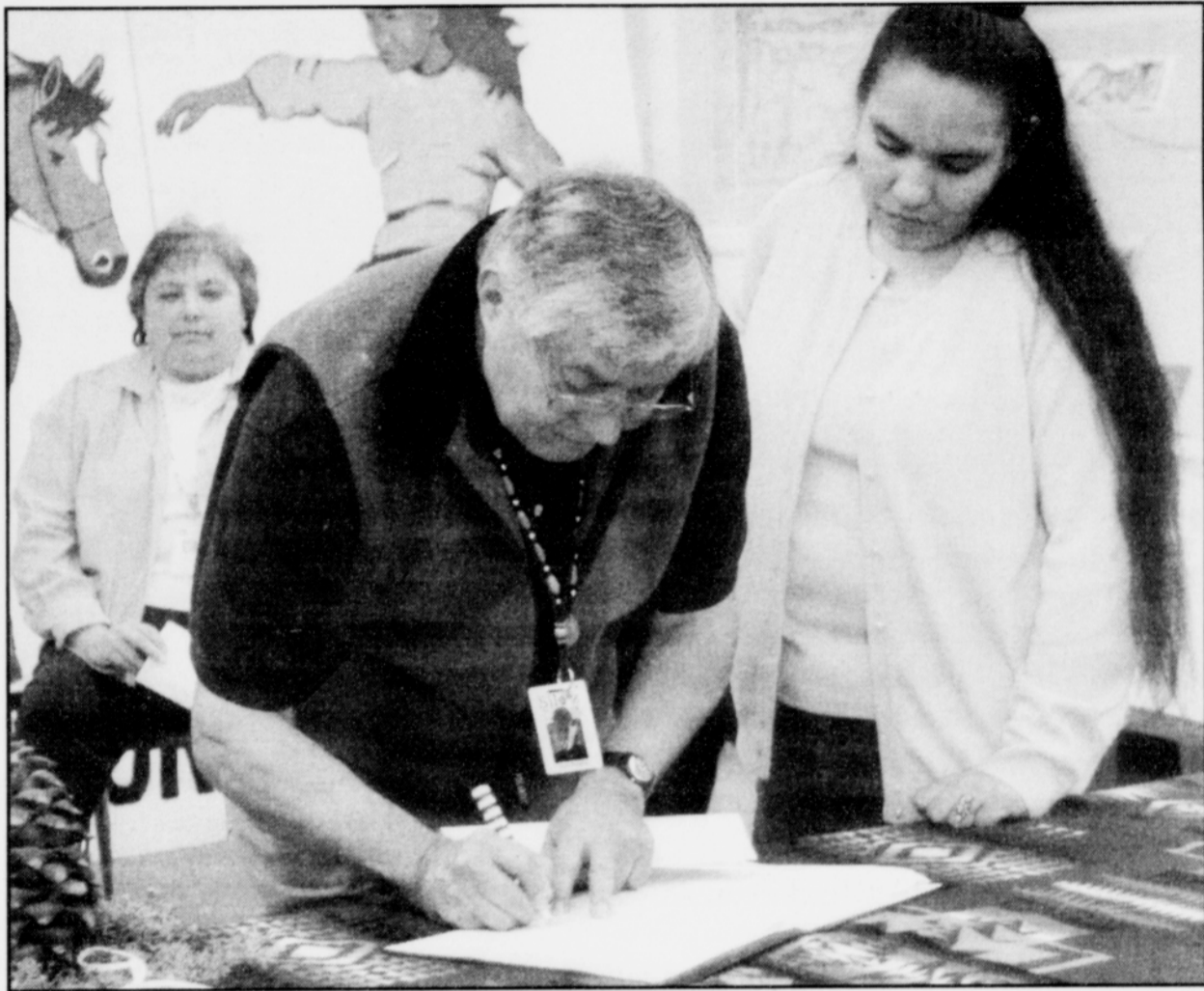
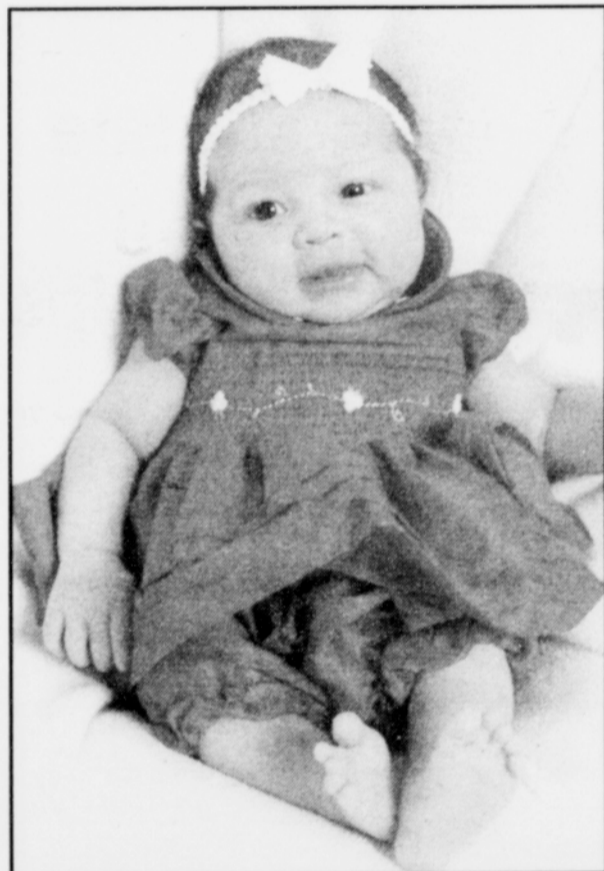




Celiyah Shaunté Covington

Sarah, we wish you the very best!

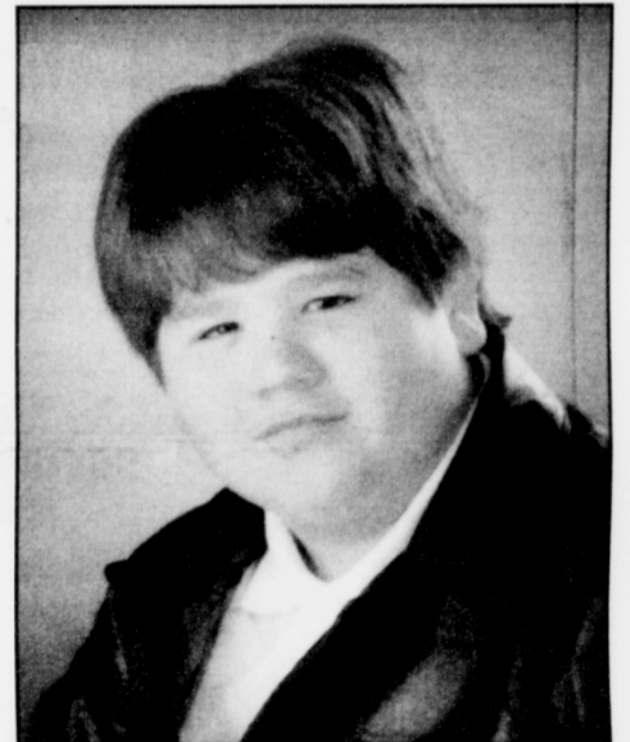
Butler Makes Honor Roll
