Mendoza Helps Team Capture Championship

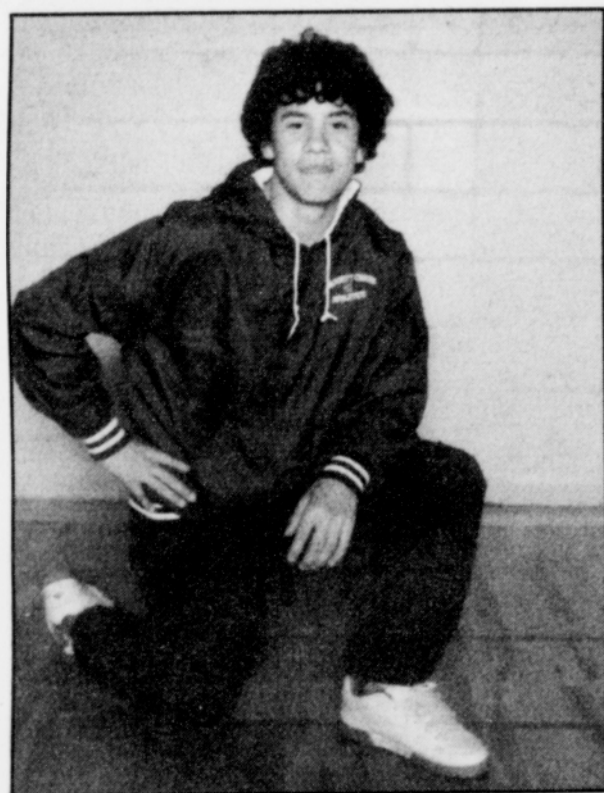

His grandparents are Gina Bennett and Henry Cole. His great-grandparents are Grandma Sue and Grandpa Gene of Siletz.

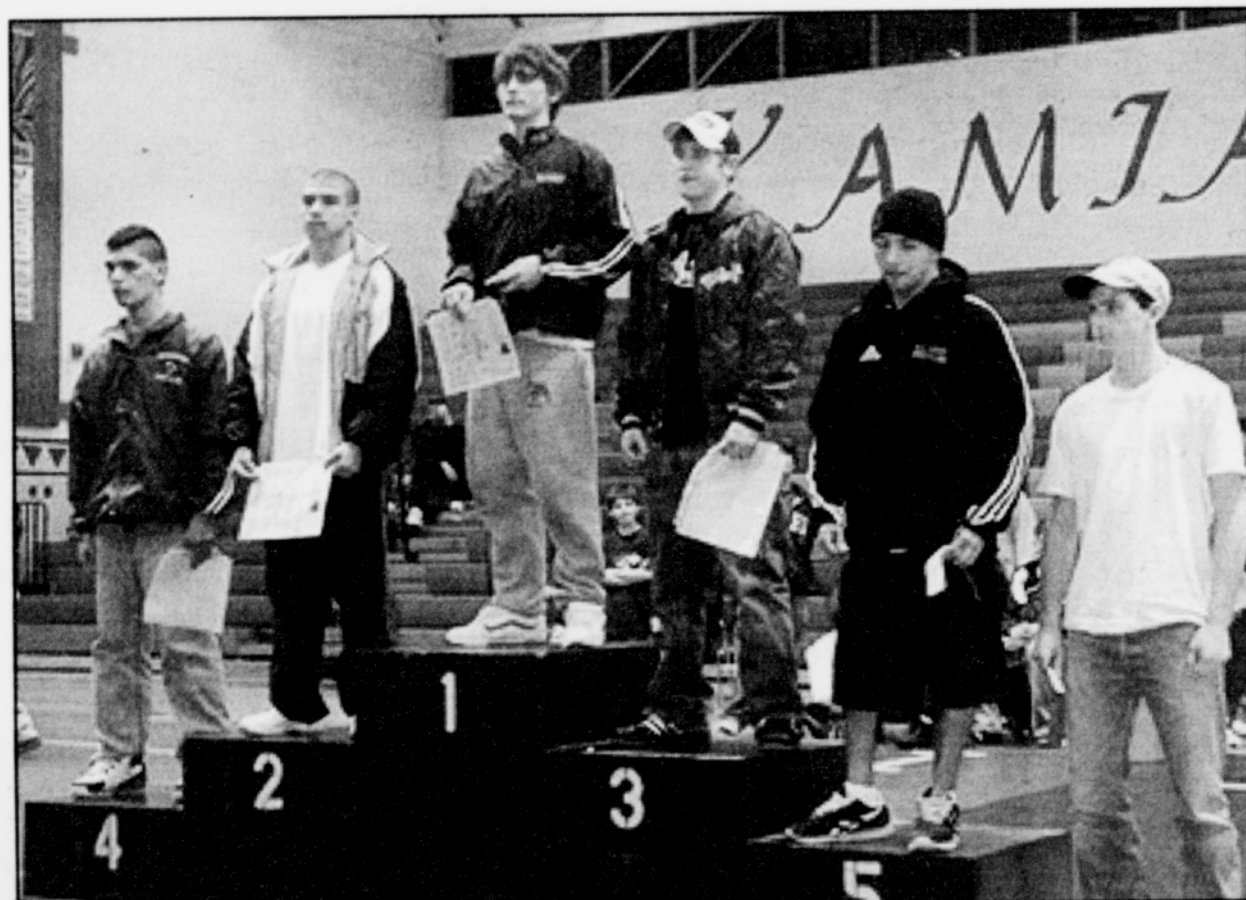


Aidan Lane Healy
