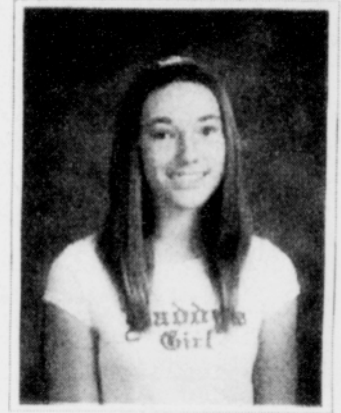
I am so proud of my daughter that I thought I would share this with you. Her name is Tinisha Rilatos, the daughter of Frank Rilatos.

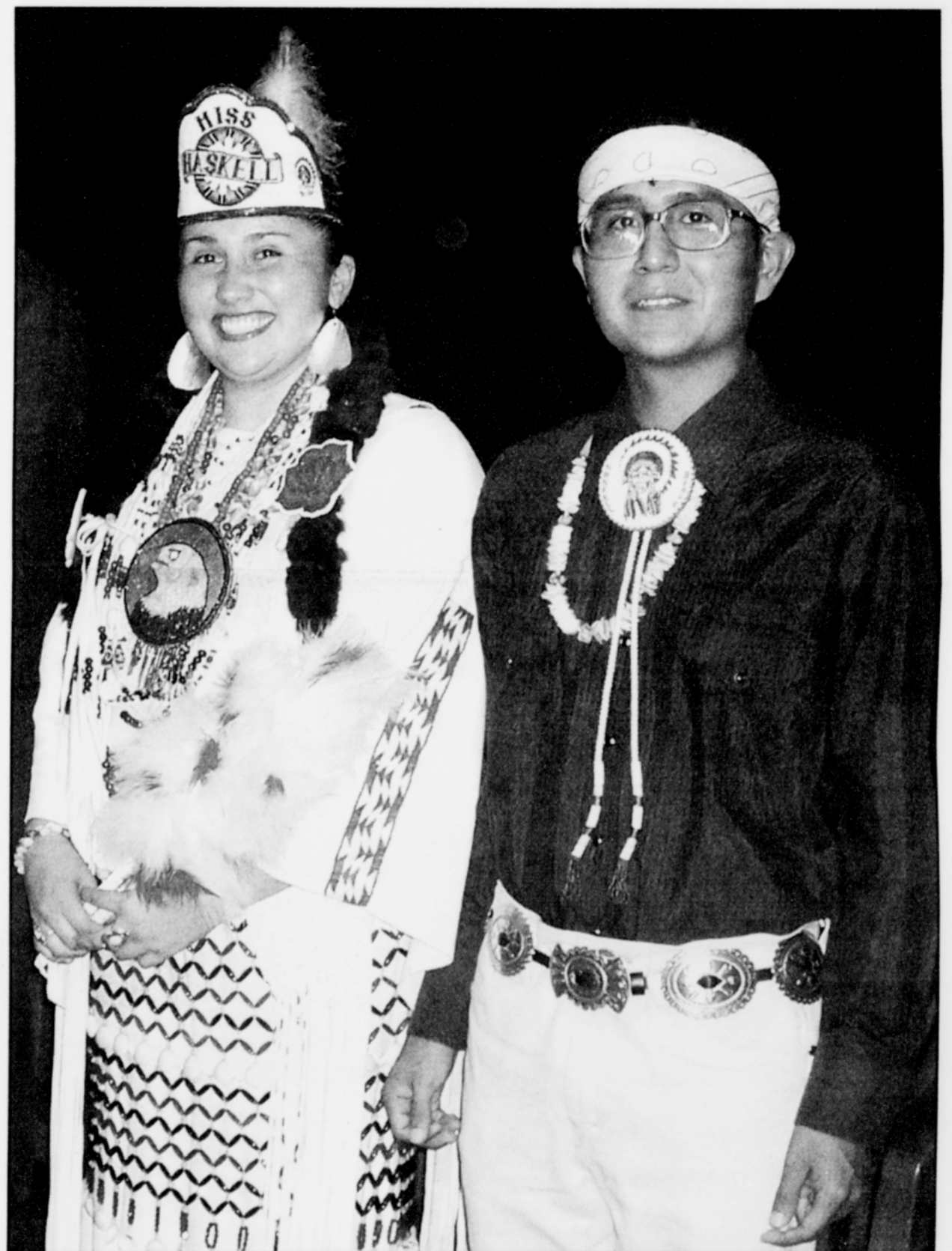
