Gladys Knight Brings Grammy-Winning Songs to Chinook Winds

Come hear the timeless sounds of Gladys Knight on April 7-8 at Chinook Wind Casino Resort.

Knight is an evolving legend in R&B music who continues to sing songs that inspire and entertain crowds across the country. Songs like *Midnight Train To Georgia*, *Mr. Love*, *Waiting On You*, and *Good Woman* are just a few of the hits you'll hear from this legendary singer.

Knight made her world premier as a solo artist on March 30, 1989, at Bally's in Las Vegas.

"This is the first time I've performed alone since we (Gladys Knight and The Pips) formed the group. I'd always been with The Pips because I wanted to be there, not because I had to be," she said.

The song *Good Woman* established Knight as a songwriter as well. She speaks enthusiastically about each of her songs as she describes the people and landscape in great detail, including the subtle motivations that animate the characters.

"I'm a lyric person," Knight continues. "I look at a lyric before I look at a melody. I live songs."

In fact, *Midnight Train To Georgia* originally was *Midnight Flight To Houston*, but Knight isn't a great fan of flying and she is from Atlanta, so she changed the song that spirited her life.

Through the years, Knight has diversified her talents in business ventures and humanitarian activities as well as stage and television. She continues to share with her fans across the country, allowing them to tap into her personal life with biography shows, in-

cluding VH1's *Behind The Music* and A&E's *Biography*.

In philanthropic efforts, Knight not only has lent her hand to the American Diabetes Association, but also the American Cancer Society, Minority AIDS Project, programs for battered women and abused children, AMFAR,

homelessness, hunger prevention, and crisis intervention. She has been honored by numerous organizations for her dedication and selflessness to help those less fortunate.

- Member of the Confederated Tribes of Siletz Indians
- Valid driver's license
- High school diploma or GED

- Ability to obtain high security gaming license

The Steering Committee's goal is to open the opportunity to three Siletz Tribal members to begin the program during 2006, with our first placement at the beginning of April.

Anyone interested in applying for the program is encouraged to submit an application to Human Resources at Chinook Winds in person, by mail, or by fax.
