## Siletz NARCH Research Project Attains Authorization

The Siletz NARCH Research Project has received its certificate of confidentiality from the National Institutes of Health and we have begun our mailings.

We have mailed consent forms to 1,000 randomly selected adult tribal members. If you receive a consent form and wish to take part in the NARCH survey, please mail the yellow copy of the form back before May 19, 2006. You then will receive the survey to be completed by June 16, 2006.

If your survey is received by the deadline, you will receive a T-shirt designed specifically for the NARCH project. Please help the Siletz Tribe by participating and returning your completed survey as soon as possible.

Overnight camping is available for families that live outside of the Siletz area **only!** Overnight campers should bring tents, sleeping bags, toiletries, etc. Campers can arrive on **July 17**, however, meals are not provided on this day.
