Siletz Fitness Center Soon to Become Reality

The Siletz Tribal Diabetes Program is pleased to announce the Siletz Tribe has been awarded ICDBG (Indian Community Development Block Grant) funding to install a 3,300-square-foot modular facility to house a Tribal Diabetes Fitness Center.

The facility will house exercise programs, education classes, and offices for two Diabetes program staff.

We want your input! Two community meetings are planned to get your

input into the building design and equipment. They are scheduled for June 26 at 12:30 p.m. in the tribal administration building lunchroom (lunch will be served) and at 6 p.m. at the Tribal Community Center (Government Hill; a light snack will be served).
