Wager, Yell Wed in Hawaii

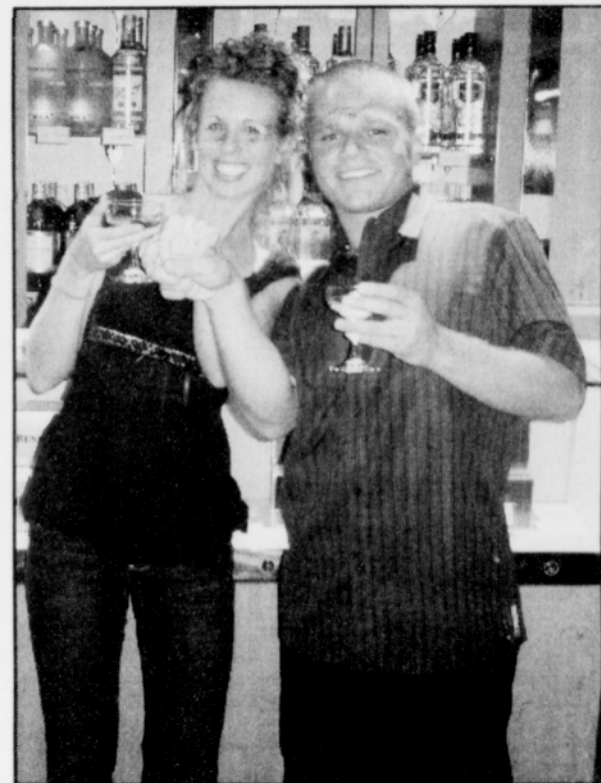
