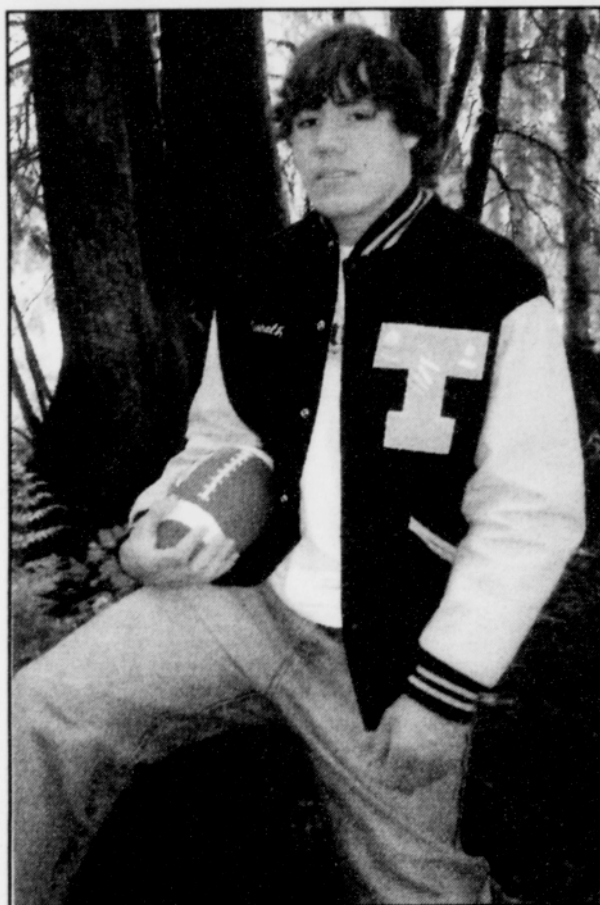


Louie Rippin Orona

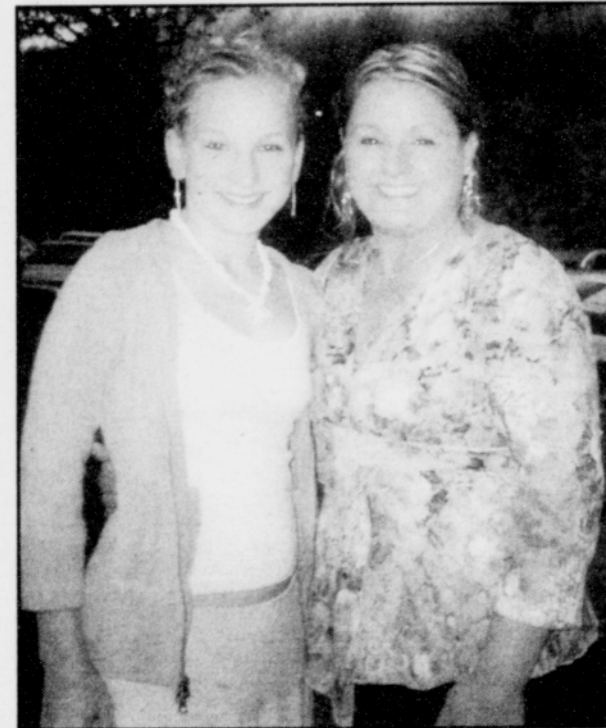
Kenneth Bradley Toledo HS

Peter was a member of the Confederated Tribes of Siletz Indians. He attended grade and high school in Salem, graduating from Sprague High School. He worked for the state of Oregon for four years at Fairview Hospital and Training Center. He joined the U.S. Navy and served for six years on the USS Anchorage.

He moved to Tacoma in the mid-1980s, where he worked in a hospital. He later was employed by the Puyallup Indian Casino in Tacoma. Peter's greatest joy was spending time with his son, Kyle; daughter, Sheila; and grandson, Kaleb. They fished, hiked, and shared many wonderful times together.

Peter is survived by his son, Kyle Carl Beals, and spouse, Mary Simmons, of Tacoma. Other survivors include his

father, Carl E. Beals, and step-mother, Sue Woodford-Beals, of Salem; and his siblings, Lori Whitaker of Portland, Ore.; Pam Fields (Bill) of Jefferson, Ore.; and Mike Beals (Laura) of Salem.

Peter also is survived by his step-brothers, Riley Woodford (Lori) of Juneau, Alaska, and Tod Woodford of Corvallis, Ore.; mother-in-law, Maureen Reardon; daughter, Sheila Clifford; son, David Simmons; grandson, Kaleb Keesy; and son-in-law, Peter Keesy (Tacoma).

Peter also will be dearly missed by the many friends he had in his community who loved him.
