Culture Camp is scheduled for July 18-20, 2006, at the Siletz Tribal Community Center and pow-wow grounds.

Culture Camp is for Siletz Tribal members only. The camp is intended for tribal families and children under age 10 must be chaperoned at all times by an adult.

### Activities

Camp planning meetings are under way. Suggested activities are basket-weaving, drum making, shell necklace making, bead working, moccasin making, shawl making, bear grass braiding, language classes, traditional foods preparation, nature walks and exercise challenge, flintknapping, storytelling, and recreational activities.

If the above-mentioned people do not show for their hearing date an Order of Default will be entered against them.

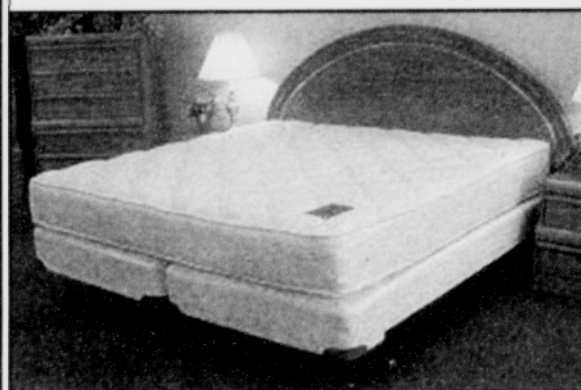

## Free Used Furniture Available

Used furniture and fixtures from 187 hotel rooms at Chinook Winds Casino Resort will soon be available to tribal members and tribal employees.

From July 26 to mid-August, the following items will be available at Chinook Winds Casino Resort:



- Queen headboards
- King headboards
- Queen mattresses and box springs
- King mattresses and box springs
- Credenzas
- Desks
- Tables
- Chairs
- Nightstands
- Lamps
- Mirrors
- Pictures

Tribal members will have first priority on selection of these items. These items are being for personal or family use only. Items will be distributed to tribal members and tribal employees as a priority, and any remaining merchandise will be distributed in local communities.

You will receive a call back or an e-mail to see what items you would like to get and information on when and where to pick them up.



You are responsible for picking up all items requested; neither the tribe nor Chinook Winds will deliver any merchandise.

The number of items available per request may be limited.

## Apply for Over-Income Grants for Your Home

The Over-Income Rehabilitation Construction program funds over-income families with a \$5,000 grant for construction rehabilitation on the primary residence they own or families who have possessor rights to their home.

Rehabilitation refers to repairs or renovations to the home, but does not include appliances, saunas, hot tubs, swimming pools, etc.

Over-Income refers to tribal members whose income exceeds the income limits set by the Native American Housing Assistance and Self-Determination Act (NAHASDA). These are listed as follows:

1	32,500	5	50,100
2	37,100	6	53,800
3	41,800	7	57,550
4	46,400	8	61,250

If you are a Siletz Tribal member and have not received an over-income grant, call the Housing office to request an application. **Applications, including proof of income, enrollment, and mortgage, must be submitted to the Housing office by July 31, 2006, at 4:30 p.m.**

Applications received after that date and time will not be accepted by the Siletz Tribal Housing Department. The selection process will be a lottery drawing of applications received by the deadline.
