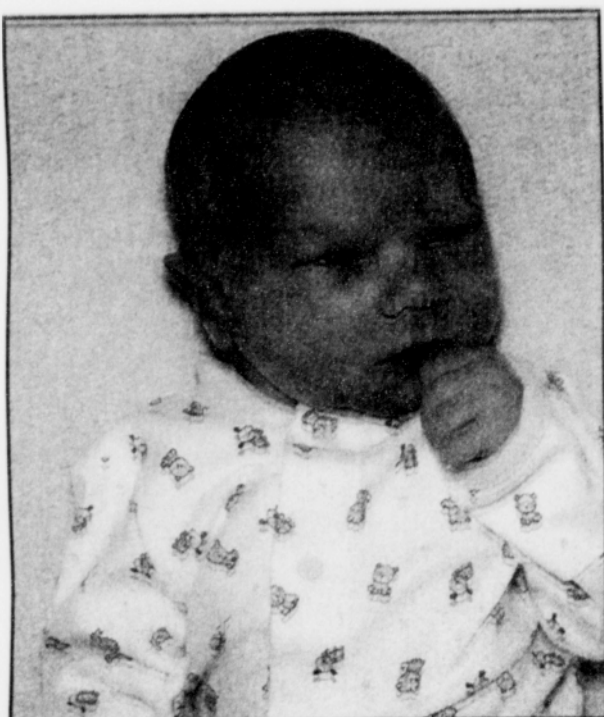

Jaylin Mya Ramsey

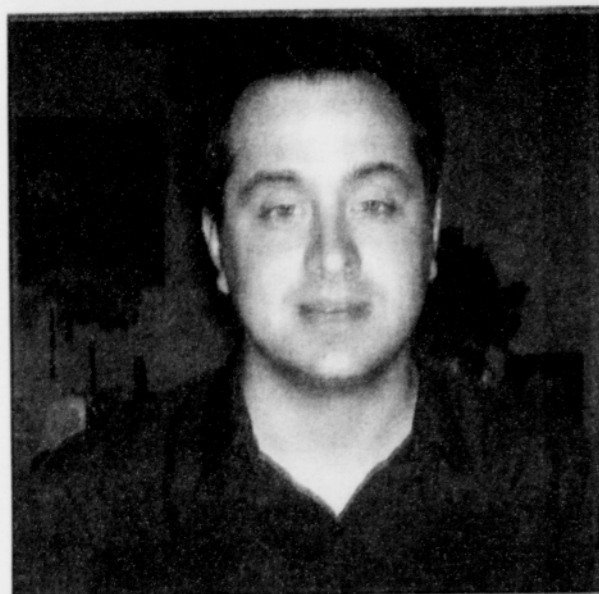
Congratulations to Jesse and Hannah Ramsey on the birth of their daughter, Jaylin Mya Ramsey.
