For 15 years, she has been a professional stand-up comedian. Television appearances include *An Evening at the Improv* and Comedy Central. Comedy clubs include Catch a Rising Star, The Ice House, The Laff Stop, The Improv, and The Laugh Factory.

Yaffee is a gifted writer and performer blazing his way across the stand-up comedy scene.

With an original but relatable comedy style, his material has been a hit with corporate, casino, and club audiences alike.

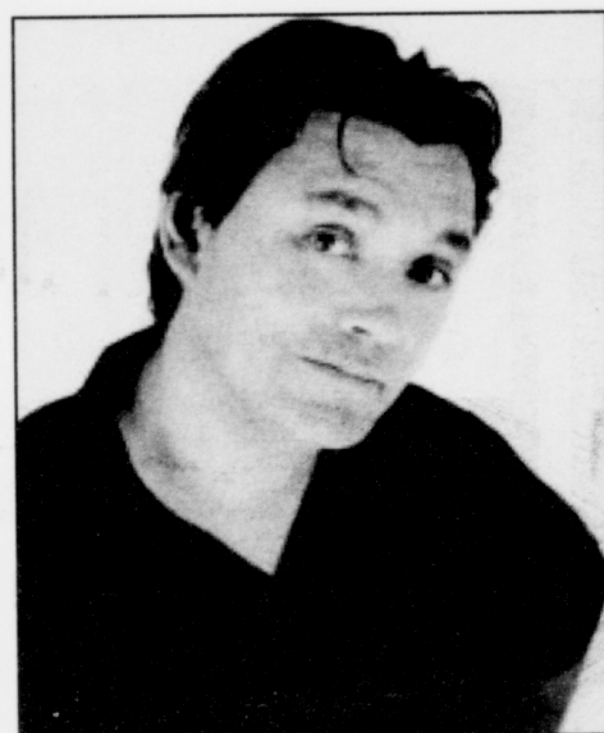
