Jeff Capri's style touches on everything from the tacitly mundane to the ridiculous. His appearances range from comedy clubs and national television appearances to a USO celebrity tour. His ability to work clean while keeping a caustic cynical edge is evidence of a well-seasoned professional.

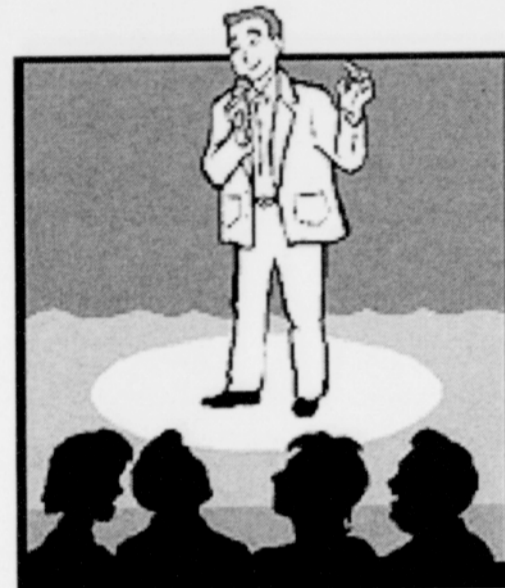
Capri has appeared alongside many respected entertainers, including Ellen DeGeneres, Tim Allen, and Sinbad.
