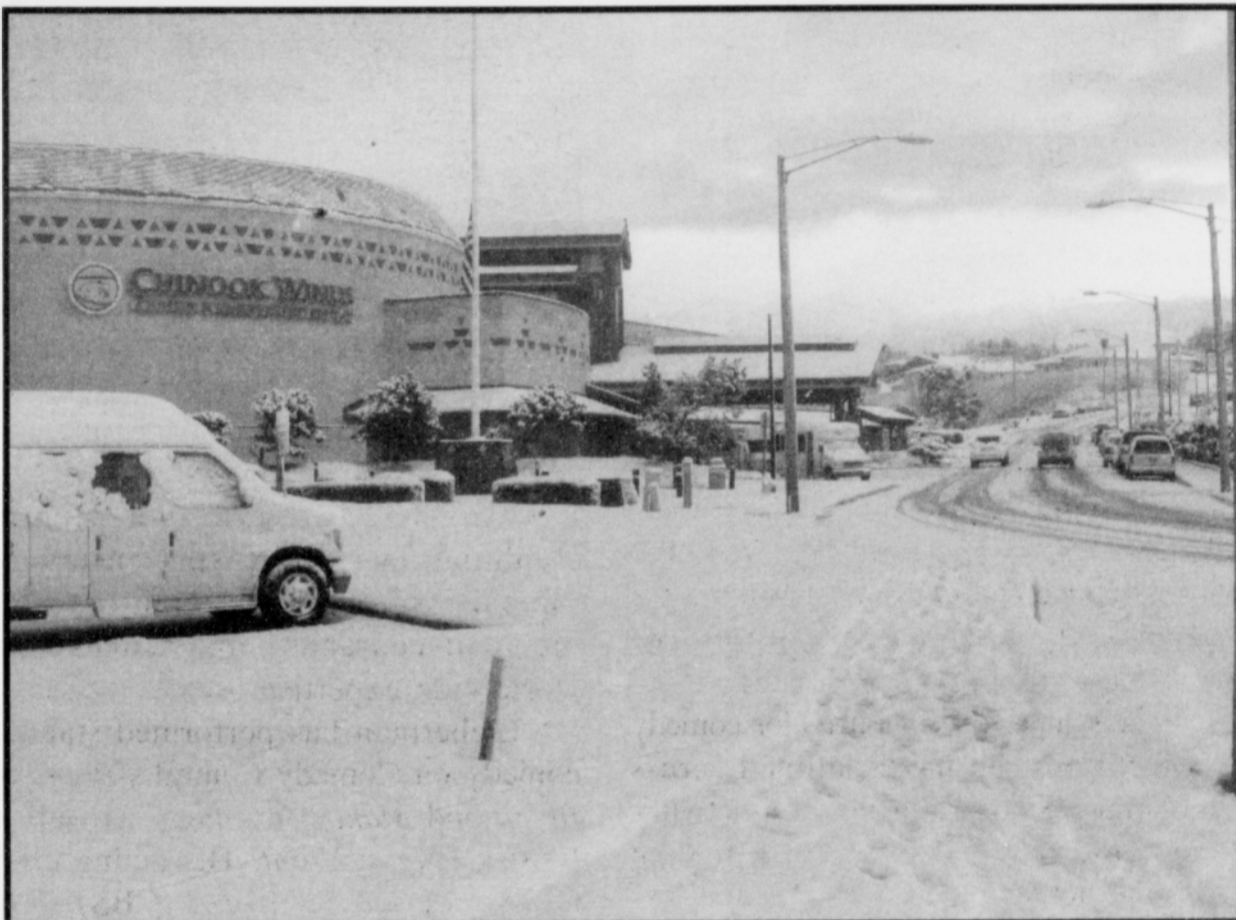
The day of the show, **Feb. 25, 2007:**

Siletz Tribal artisans and Chinook Winds Casino Resort employees will sell their creations at the Chinook Winds Arts & Crafts Fair on Feb. 17-18 in the Chinook Winds Convention Center.

This event is open to all ages and there is no charge for admission.

This is your chance to purchase hand-crafted items direct from the skilled individuals who create them. There also will be a tribal history display as part of Antique Week. The event will be held in conjunction with the Harry Rinker Appraisathon also taking place in the casino's convention center.
