

## Beach Battle Pro-Am Boxing Premieres

Chinook Winds Casino Resort presents the premiere of *Beach Battle Pro-Am*, professional and Olympic-style amateur boxing, on March 31.

History will be made in Oregon as professional and amateur boxers take the ring at the same event. The amateur side is sanctioned by USA Boxing, the national governing body for all amateur boxing in the United States. This event will feature up-and-coming amateur boxers from the

Northwest and helps establish senior youth boxing records for consideration as Olympic contenders.



The fight card will include two professional bouts, along with as many as six amateur bouts. *Beach Battle* is a family event and is open to all ages. A beer garden will be open to those age 21 and older.

Tickets are affordably priced at \$17 for general admission and \$30 for ringside seats. Doors open at 6 p.m. and the first bout begins at 7 p.m.

Griffith's selection as Superstar for the fourth quarter of 2006 was the result of a nomination submitted by a
