Medal Ceremony

Many of you might have seen the article in the previous issue of *Siletz News* regarding the Veterans of Oregon Honorable Service Medal presentation ceremony. Our Honor Guard and any veterans can participate in the rededication ceremonies at Chinook Winds Casino Resort on Sept. 30, 2007. Many events are scheduled for that day.

As part of the rededication of the Veterans Memorial, a presentation of medals will be made to Oregon veterans. A new custom-designed, engraved medal in appreciation for the service and sacrifice of veterans from the state of Oregon will be presented to Oregon veterans in attendance.

To qualify for the medal, a form must be filled out in advance of the ceremony, with proof of military service attached. Forms will be on hand at Chinook Winds beginning Sept. 28 in a tent near the flag display. To access them in advance, go to www.veteransoforegon.com.
