## The Commodores Stop at the Beach on World Tour

The *Brick House* of singing sensations is coming to Lincoln City this month when The Commodores perform live on Oct. 26-27.

They will be singing old favorites like *Lady (You Bring Me Up)*, *Three Times a Lady* and *Brick House*.

Through the years, The Commodores have delivered hit after hit while holding true to their music. After original lead singer Lionel Richie left in 1983, original co-lead vocalist Walter "Clyde" Orange, along with original band member William "WAK" King, interviewed more than 50 vocalists to find the perfect match for the group.

In 1984, James Dean "J.D." Nicholas joined The Commodores and shortly after in 1986 the group won a Grammy for the song *Night Shift*.

The group hasn't relied on its early hits. Instead, it has continued to put out quality work. With the creation of their new label, The Commodores released *Commodores Hits Vol. I*, *Commodores*

*Hits Vol. II*, *Commodores Christmas*, and *Commodores XX-No Tricks*.

The newest CD, *Commodores Live*, was recorded during the group's 1997 U.S. tour and released in December 1998, along with the TV special of the same name.

The successful Commodores of the present not only have produced six new albums and embarked upon a




worldwide tour, they also have created their own record label, Commodores Records and Entertainment. Today, The Commodores stand not only as talented and successful musicians, but also as artists determined to continue their success into the future.
