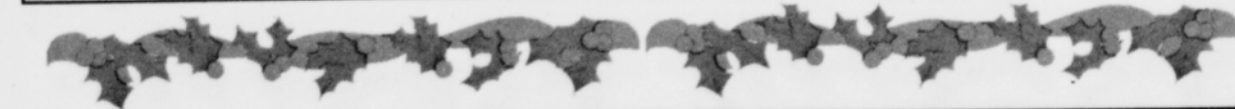
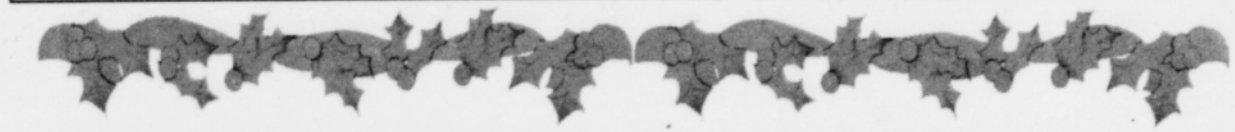
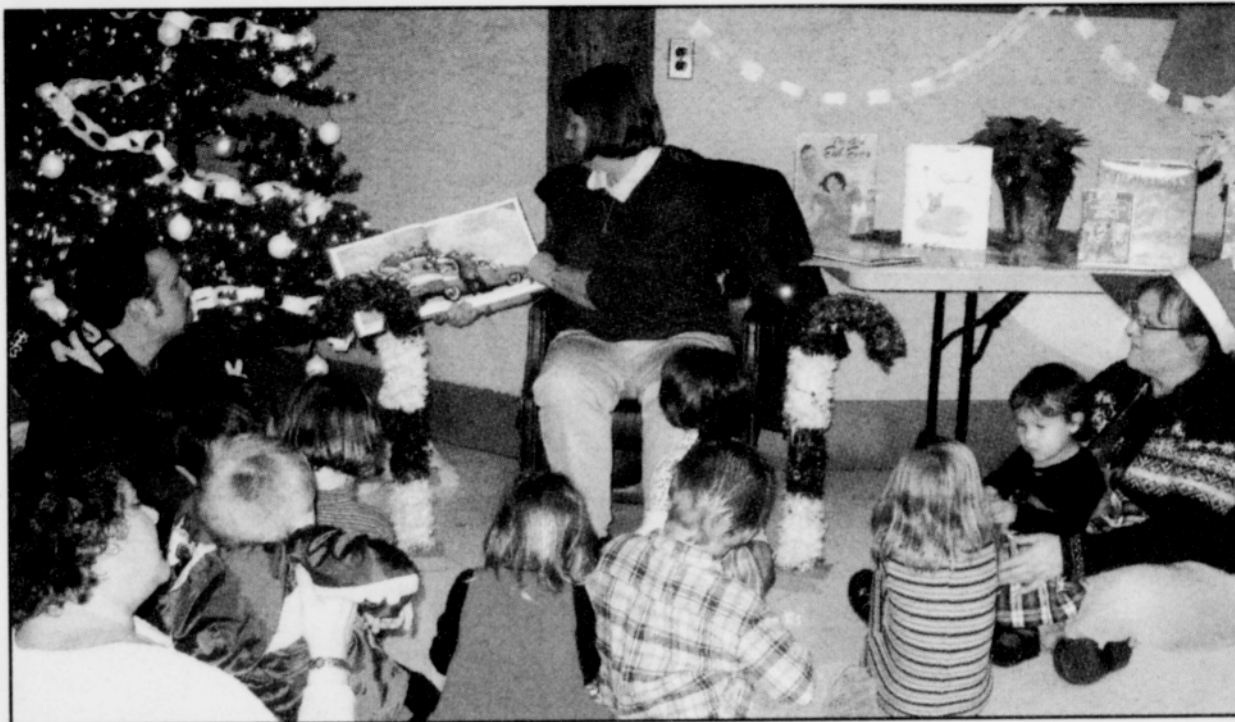
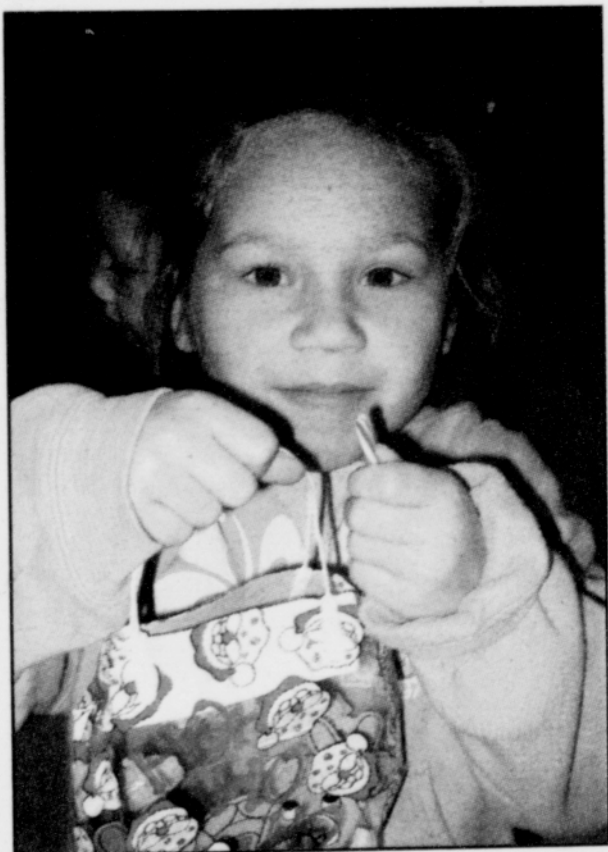


Siletz Community
