Often referred to as the "heir apparent" to the legendary George Jones, Kershaw helped make the '90s a shining decade for country music. His platinum albums were propelled into the records books by such hits as *She Don't Know She's Beautiful*, *National Working Woman's Holiday*, *Love Of My Life*, *Cadillac Style*, *Don't Go Near The Water*, *Haunted Heart* and many others.

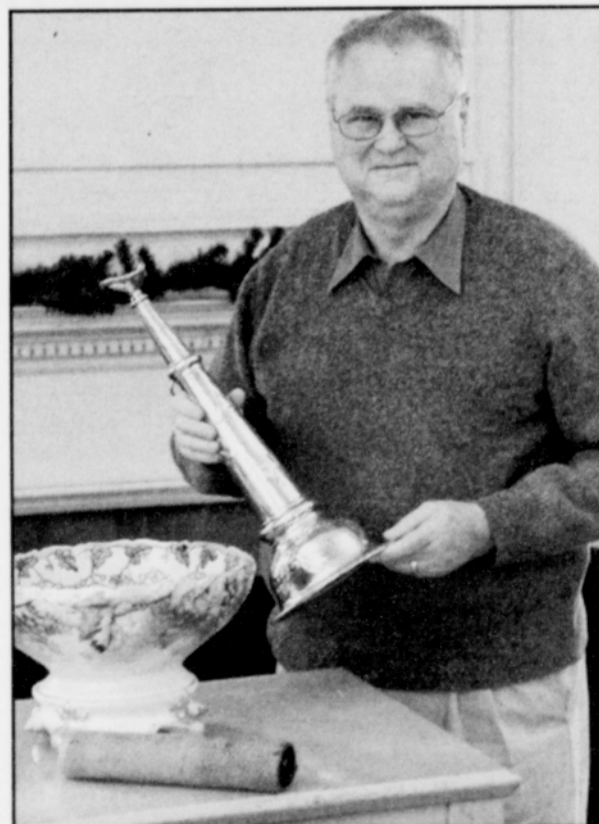
