3rd Annual S.T.Y.L.E. (Siletz Tribal Youth Living Empowered) Coed Native Basketball Tournament April 24-27, 2008

The S.T.Y.L.E. Coed Native Basketball Tournament will be held April 24-27, 2008.

Youth teams up to eight players, including two non-Native alternates if needed, have been invited from around the Pacific Northwest and the 11-county service area. Recruitment began in January 2008 with invitations sent to all nine tribes of Oregon and various tribes in Southern Washington.

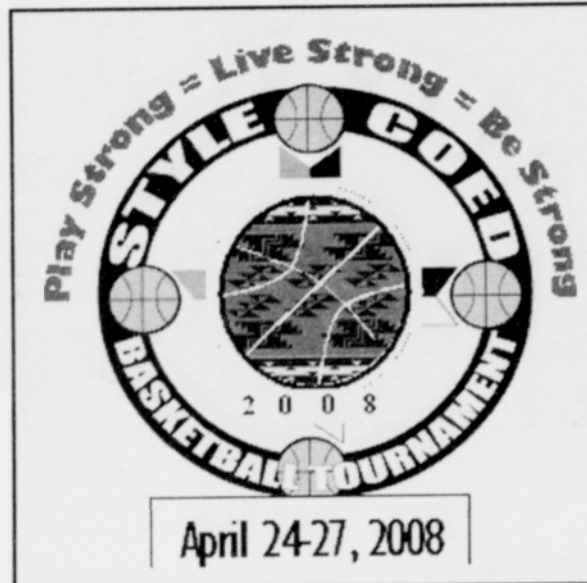
In 2006, the S.T.Y.L.E. Volunteer Committee took up the challenge to re-establish a basketball tournament in Siletz. The committee and youth volunteers did fund-raisers, submitted funding requests and obtained donations throughout the year to raise funds for a basketball tournament in April 2007 with an attendance of more than 350 people.

The S.T.Y.L.E. volunteer board has worked hard to ensure funding for this

year's tournament. Fund-raising for the 2008 competition has been under way for the last year and will continue through March.
