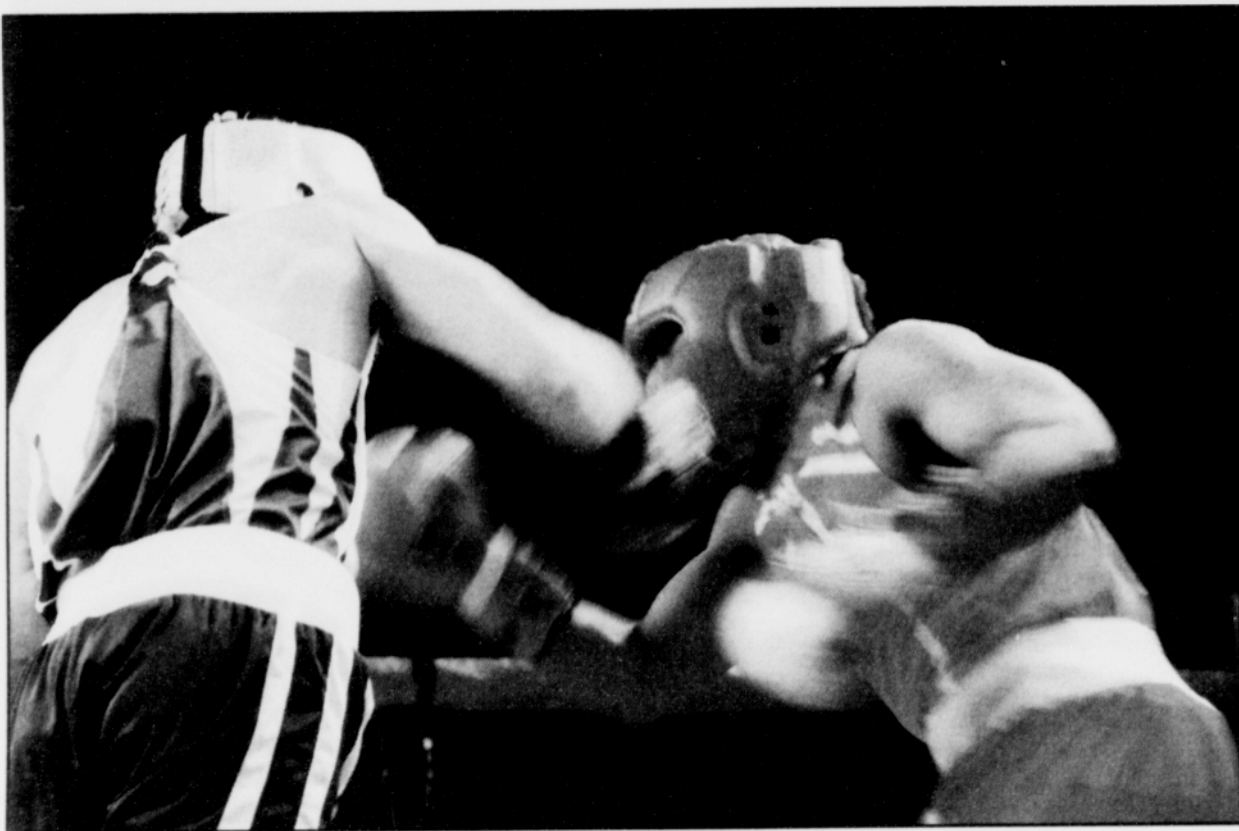

Guidelines for Vendors Attending the Oregon Native Market

1. Our Oregon Native Market is defined by the following description: Arts, crafts and pre-packaged food

- items constructed or made by Native Indians with an active roll number.
2. Vendors participating in our event can only sell items they have made by hand and cannot sell items made by other craftsman at their booth.
3. Vendors cannot sell ordered items mixed in with handmade items.
4. Vendors will set up their booth May 23 by 10 p.m. for first day and be open May 24 to do business at 9 a.m.
5. Vendors may begin to dismantle their booths at 4 p.m. May 25.

The Oregon Native Market is for Native Indians to show their crafts and heritage. We want the public to have an experience of seeing what Native American crafts and culture is really about without mixing it with items that would confuse the public. We are proud to host this event and hope that you will be proud to join us in celebrating our heritage.

By participating in the Oregon Native Market you agree to adhere to the above-stipulated guidelines. If any of the above is not adhered to or it is found that the vendor is not of Native decent with roll number, we may exercise the right to not allow them to participate in the Oregon Native Market. If it is found that the crafts that are being sold are not handmade by the Vendor or made by another not represented at the Vendor booth, except helping an Elder, we may exercise the right to not allow them to continue to participate in the Oregon Native Market.

We are requiring a donation of an item worth \$25 or more for our drawings. These items will be chosen by a committee of Native Americans attending the Market.

We are looking forward to seeing you at the Market.

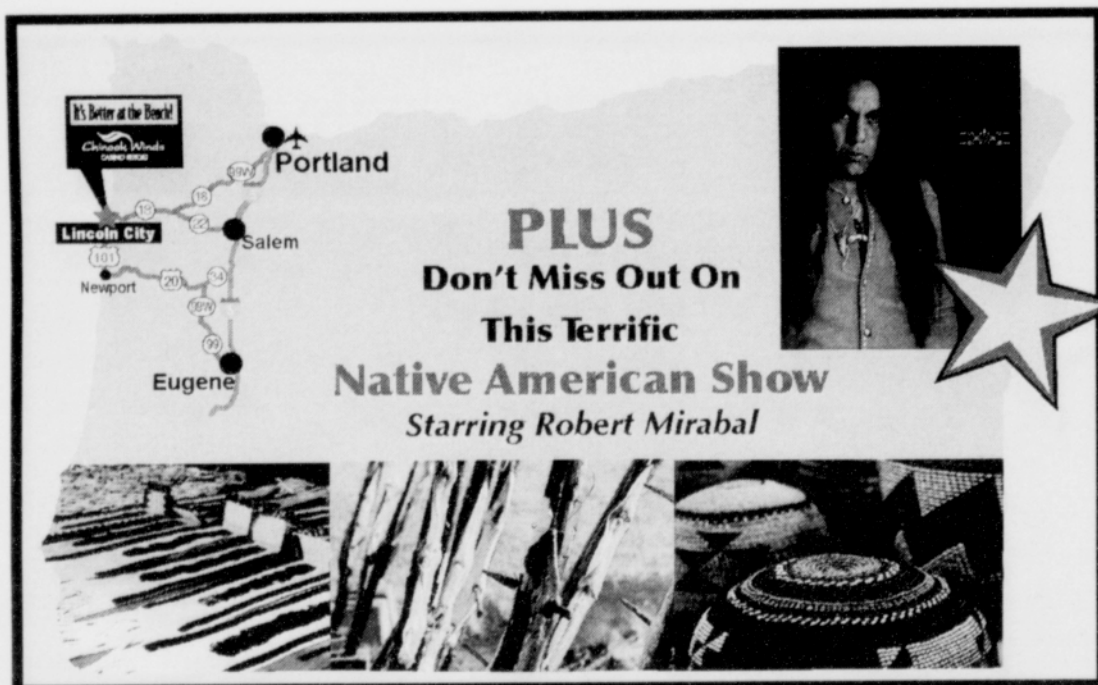

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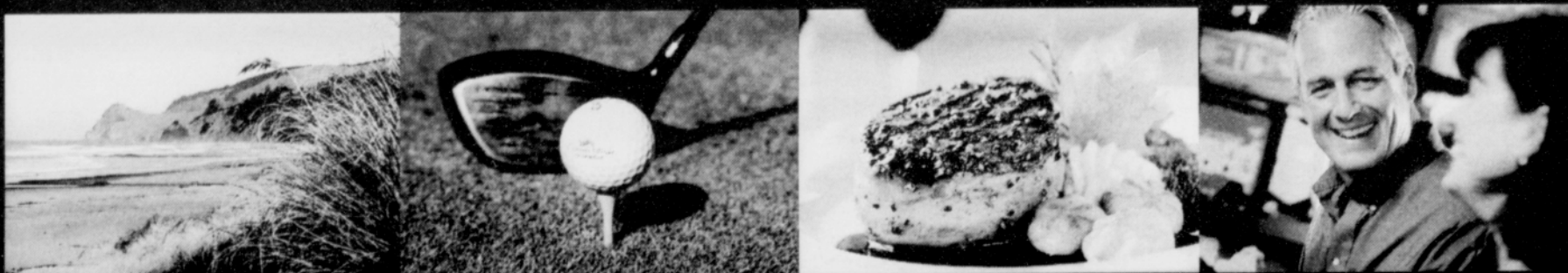
