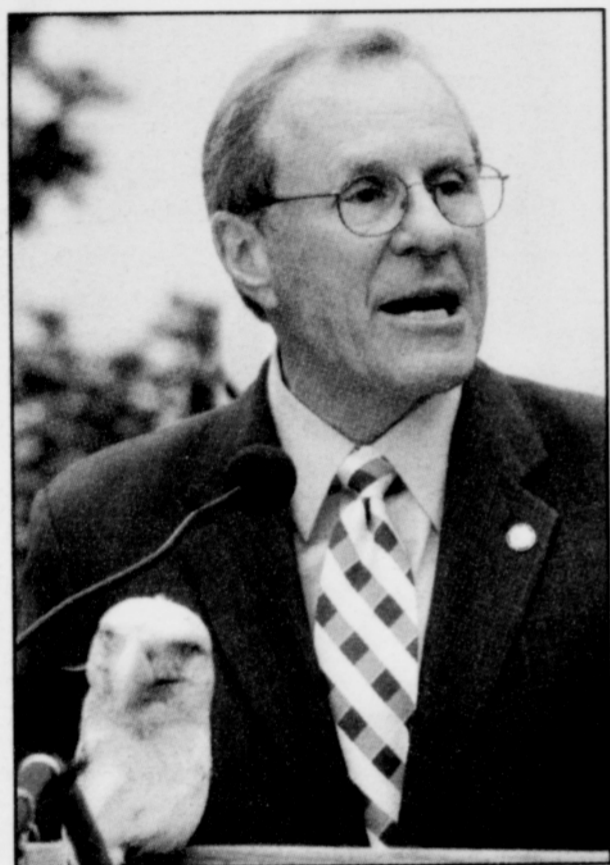

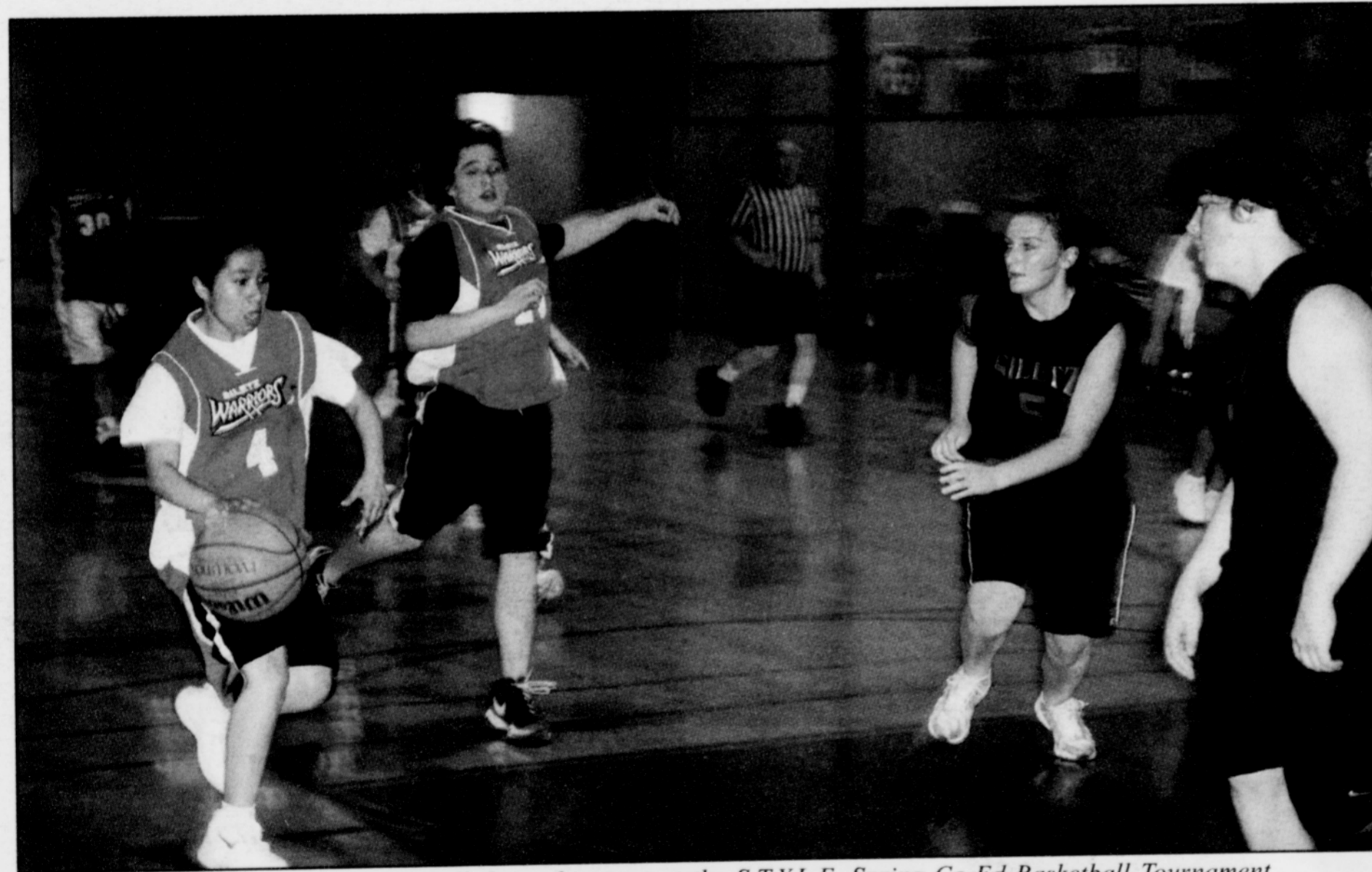


Gov. Ted Kulongoski speaks to an audience on Tribal Information Day that included representatives of all nine of the state's recognized Tribes.
