- Verification of child care paid
- Tribal ID or CIB, SS cards or numbers for all household members
- If you live with someone not on the application, we need a statement from them about your living arrangements
- Picture ID for all adult household members

Job Openings

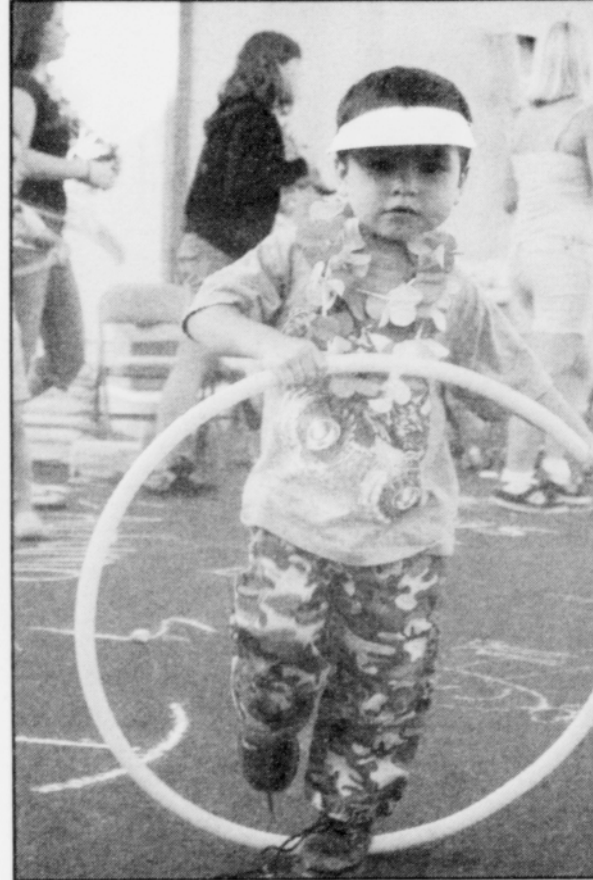

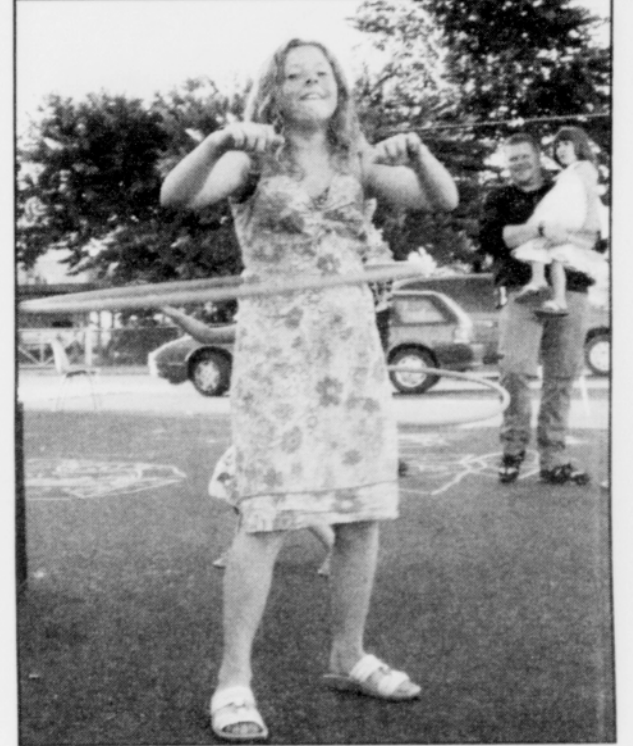
