Cut Wood for the Elders Day

The Tribal Natural Resources Committee and Natural Resources Department will sponsor another "Cut Wood for the Elders Day" on **Aug. 23**. The woodcut will be held at the old log yard at the Tribe's **Toledo Mill property**.

We need lots of volunteers to help split firewood for Tribal elders. Bring

your hydraulic wood splitters, splitting mauls, axes and lots of energy. Even if you don't have any of those, we can use the moral support!

Lunch, drinks and snacks will be provided. We will meet at the Tribal administration building at **7 a.m.** and caravan to the mill. For anyone wishing to come

later, directions to the mill will be posted on the front door of the building.

The goal of this event will be to stockpile firewood for future delivery to elders. Elders' Coordinator Angela Ramirez maintains a list of elders who burn wood for their winter heat.

People willing to haul firewood to

elders outside of the Siletz area should contact Angela at 800-922-1399, ext. 1225, or 541-444-8225 and she will pair you up with an elder in need. We especially need folks who can haul wood to the Eugene, Salem and Portland areas.

If you have parents or grandparents who burn wood in the winter to stay warm, you need to help out at this event. **The last woodcut event was very poorly attended. The future of these events will depend on the number of volunteers who show up to this woodcut!**

Firewood Area Closed

Effective July 14, the Tribe's firewood cutting area (North Fork #2) will be closed because of fire season. This area will most likely stay closed until the fall rains begin. We will put out word when it reopens.

Fire Season Regulated Use in Effect

With the summer heat comes fire season in the forest. Effective July 14, the following regulations are in effect within all forestlands in Lincoln County, **including** Tribal forestlands:

- Smoking is prohibited while traveling, except in vehicles on improved (rocked or paved) roads.
- Open fires are prohibited, including campfires, charcoal fires, cooking fires and warming fires, except at designated locations. Portable cooking stoves using liquefied or bottled fuels are allowed.
- Chain saw use is prohibited.
- Use of motorized vehicles, including motorcycles and all-terrain vehicles, is prohibited, except on improved (rocked or paved) roads.
- Possession of the following fire fighting equipment is required while traveling, except on state highways, county roads and driveways: one shovel and one gallon of water or one 2½-pound or larger fire extinguisher.
- Use of fireworks is prohibited.
- Cutting, grinding and welding of metal is prohibited.
