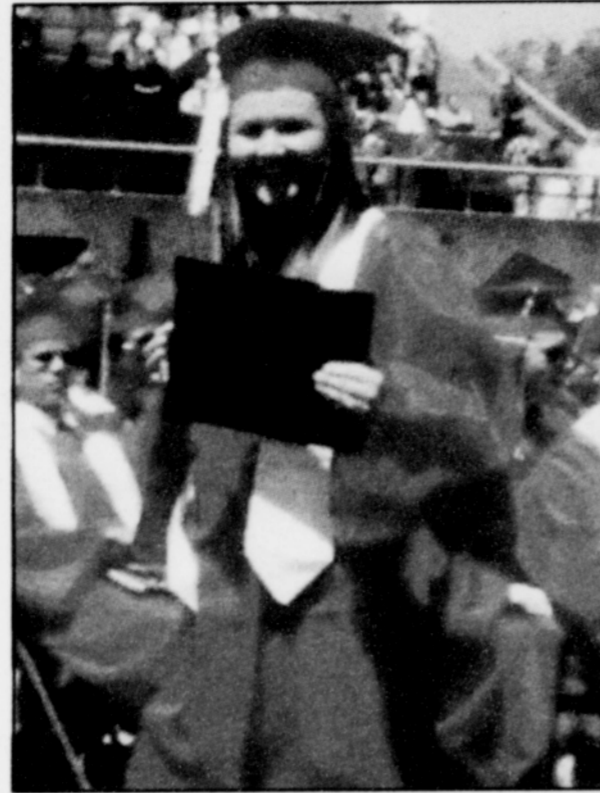


Katelyn Hedrick Army Boot Camp

Danielle Janeen (DJ) McNair graduated from Taft High School in Lincoln City, Ore. She's the daughter of Doug and Jacque McNair.

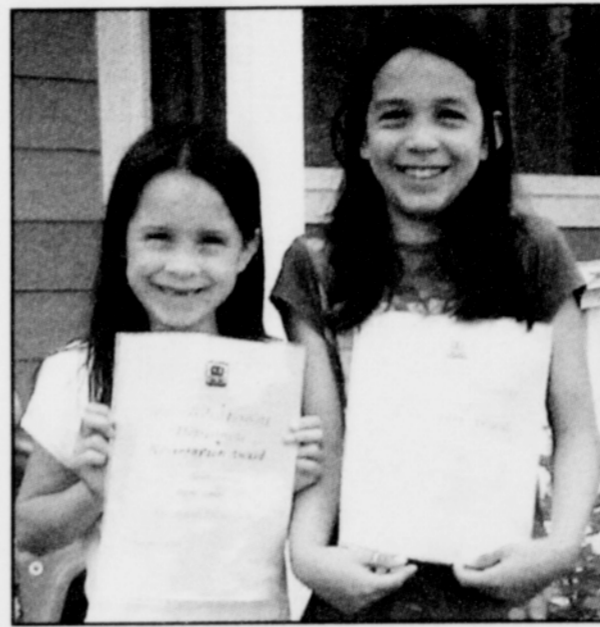

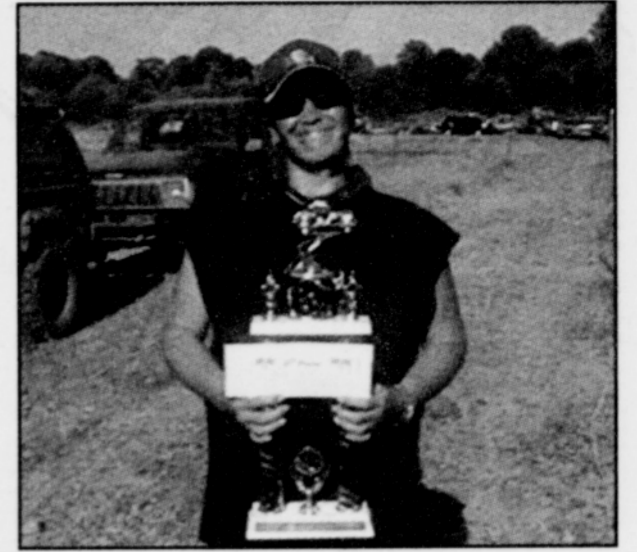
Asprias Clean Up Housing Area
