Greg Travis, Mike Wally Walter and Brian Diamond bring laughter to the beach Sept. 12-13 at Comedy on the Coast.

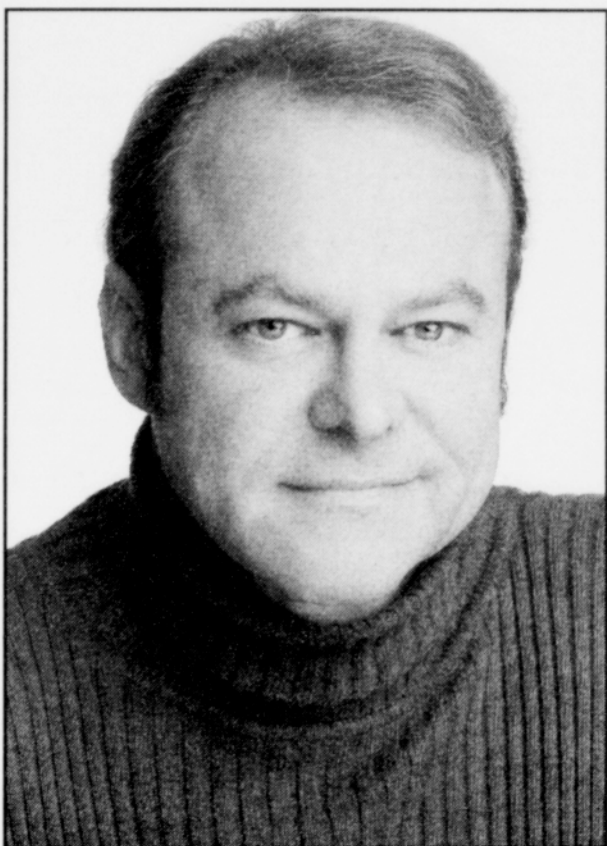
Headlining the evening is Greg Travis, who has appeared in more than 30 feature films. He has the ability to play a wide range of characters, which makes his standup show hilarious.
