this employee; we look forward to seeing them when we return."

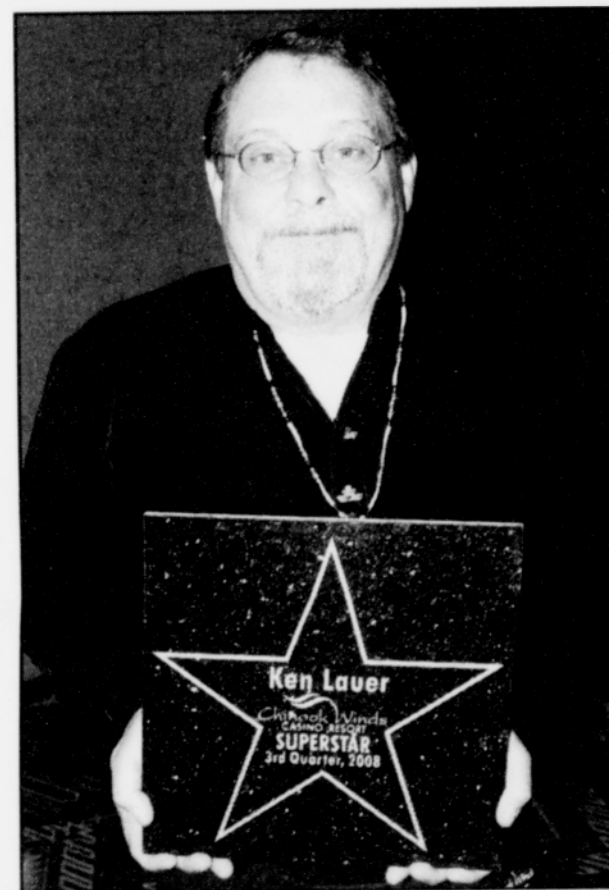
