Little River Band Brings Back Five-Part Harmonies

The Little River Band will bring its rich five-part harmonies to Chinook Winds on Feb. 20-21. Of their glistening vocals, Glenn Frey of The Eagles once said they were the best harmonizing band in the business.

Prior to the success of AC/DC, Air Supply, Men At Work and INXS, the Little River Band was Australia's most successful international rock band. Formed in 1975 in Melbourne, Australia, the band is celebrating 29 years of making music that has included 10 Top Ten hits in the United States from its 14 albums, with total sales exceeding 25 million units.

The band is known for its famous harmonies and for hits such as *Lonesome Loser*, *Lady*, *Cool Change* and *Reminiscing*.

Show time is 8 p.m. Tickets range from \$15 to \$30.

Charley Pride Returns with Best-Selling Country Hits

The legendary Charley Pride will perform live at Chinook Winds on Feb. 6-7.

Over the past 30 years, Pride has remained one of the Top 20 best-selling country artists of all time. His incredible legacy comprises more than 70 million albums sold, 31 gold and four platinum albums – including one quadruple platinum album.

Born to poor sharecroppers as one of 11 children, Pride has had an illustrious music career. His body of work includes 29 No. 1 hits on the Billboard country singles chart, including *Is Anybody Goin' To San Antone*, *Kiss An Angel Good Mornin'*, *(I'm So) Afraid Of Losing You Again*, *Mississippi Cotton Picking Delta Town*, *Someone Loves You Honey*, *When I Stop Leaving (I'll Be Gone)*, *Burgers And Fries*, *Mountain Of Love* and *You're So Good When You're Bad*.

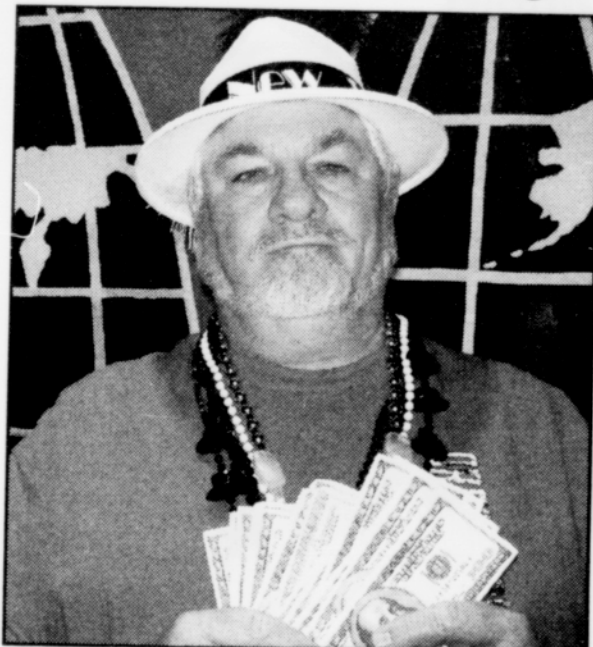
Pride was elected into the Country Music Hall of Fame in 2000.

Guests have a chance to win \$50 for winning one quarter, \$100 for two quarters, \$1,000 for three quarters and finally, \$25,000 if all four quarters are correct.
