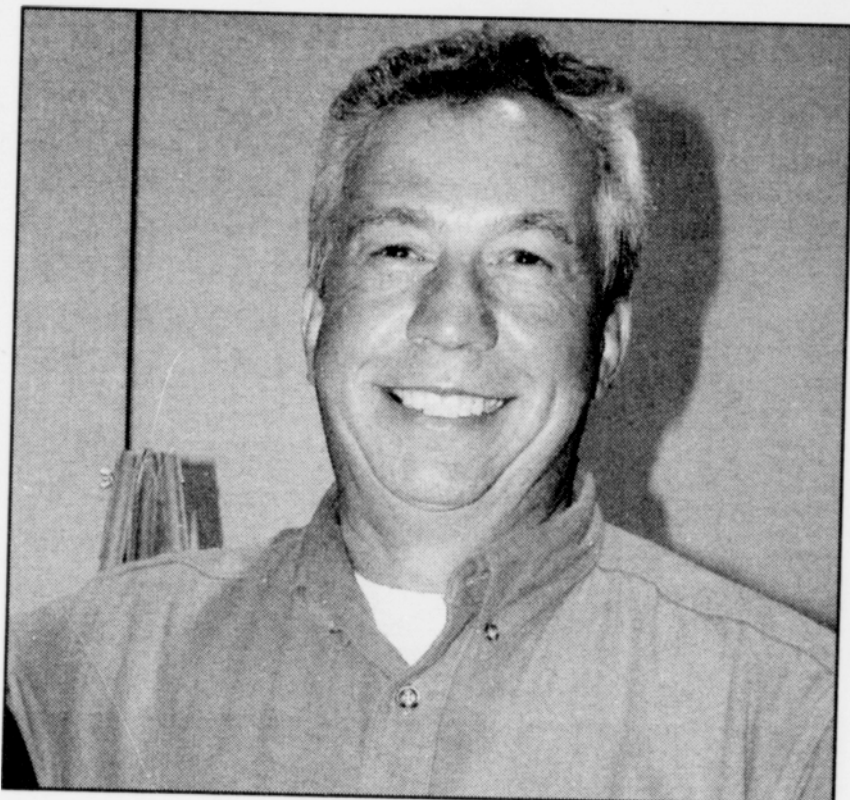

Ernie Rose of Lincoln City, an employee of Chinook Winds Golf Resort, has been selected as Chinook Winds Superstar for the fourth quarter of 2008.

From the more than 900 Chinook Winds employees, only four are selected to receive this honor each year. To be eligible, an employee must perform his or her duties at a high standard of excellence on a consistent basis and must exhibit a dedication to internal and external customer service.

Once an individual is nominated by casino staff or guests, the nomination must pass several reviews before the final selection.

If you don't believe it, count the number of times you laugh while saying, "That is so true!" He tells it like it is, never losing his smile.

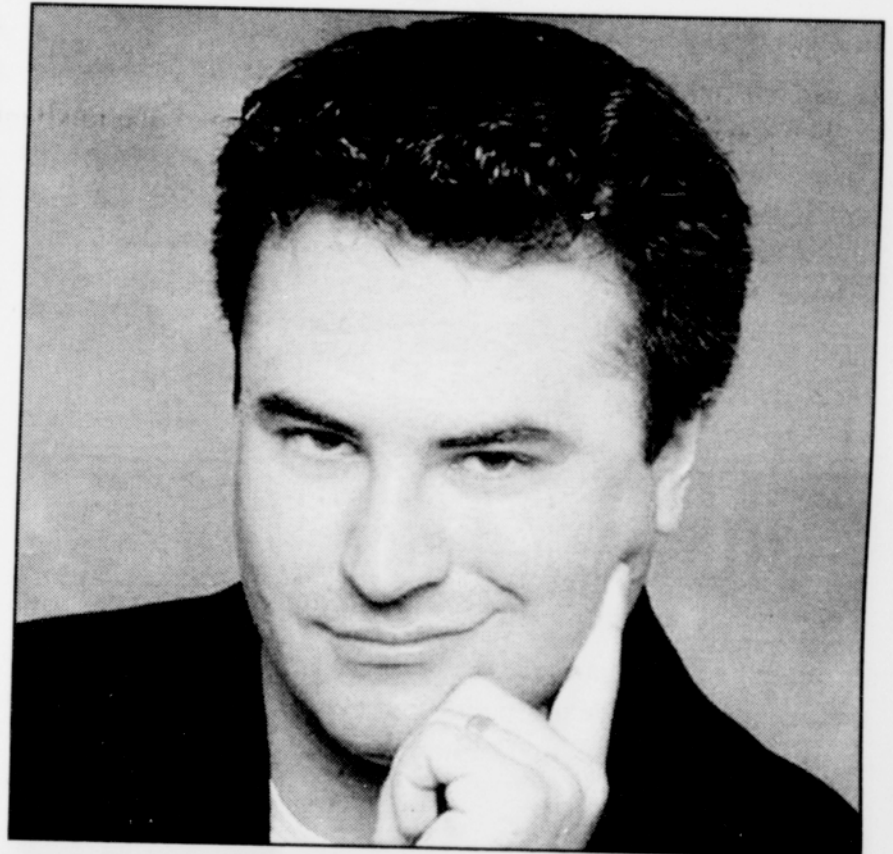
Slade is a true family man. In the '80s he traveled around the country with his family, pulling a 36-foot fifth-wheel travel trailer. When his second child was born in the trailer (they were pulled over at the time), he decided to make roots in Portland, Ore. There he was able to concentrate on his career and managed to accomplish things most comedians never do.

2002 proved to be a banner year for Slade, who became the first standup comic to make appearances at the three major North American Comedy Festivals - Aspen, Chicago and Montreal - in one year.

On the heels of his performances, Slade signed a development deal with Warner Brothers Television. He was chosen to appear on HBO's *Best of the U.S. Comedy Arts Festival* and made an appearance on Comedy Central's *Premium Blend*.

Clever material and strong stage presence have made Resler a crowd favorite at comedy clubs, college campuses and corporate events from coast to coast. He has shown tireless dedication to his craft by hitting the stage more than 320 times in a year.

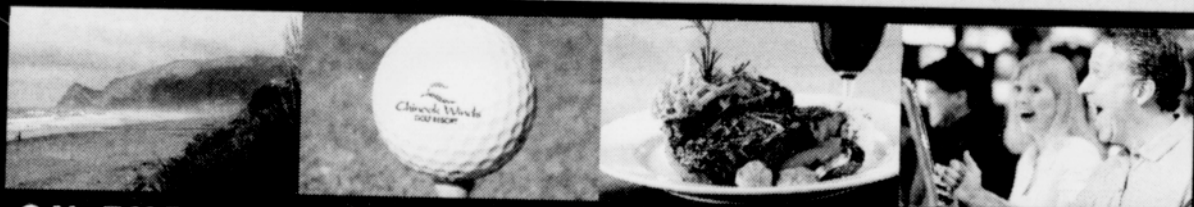
Lucky Letter Bingo - Lucky Letter 6-ons will cost \$10 and they are for all 10 main session games. If you bingo on a "B" or "O" you will win \$300, if you bingo on an "L" or "G" you will win \$500 and if you bingo on an "N" you will win \$700. Multiple winners will split the payout.

Senior Bingo - April 3rd is senior bingo day. If you are 55 years or older and a single winner on a main session game we will give an extra \$5 for every year of your life added to your payout.

Monitor Bingo and Beads - For all main games we will pull up an extra ball after a bingo has been verified and if you win on that ball you will win \$25. Multiple winners will split the payout. Also all winners on all games and monitor winners will receive a free bead with their win.

Pull-Tab Day - All guests that buy-in will receive a pull-tab on Tuesdays in April.
