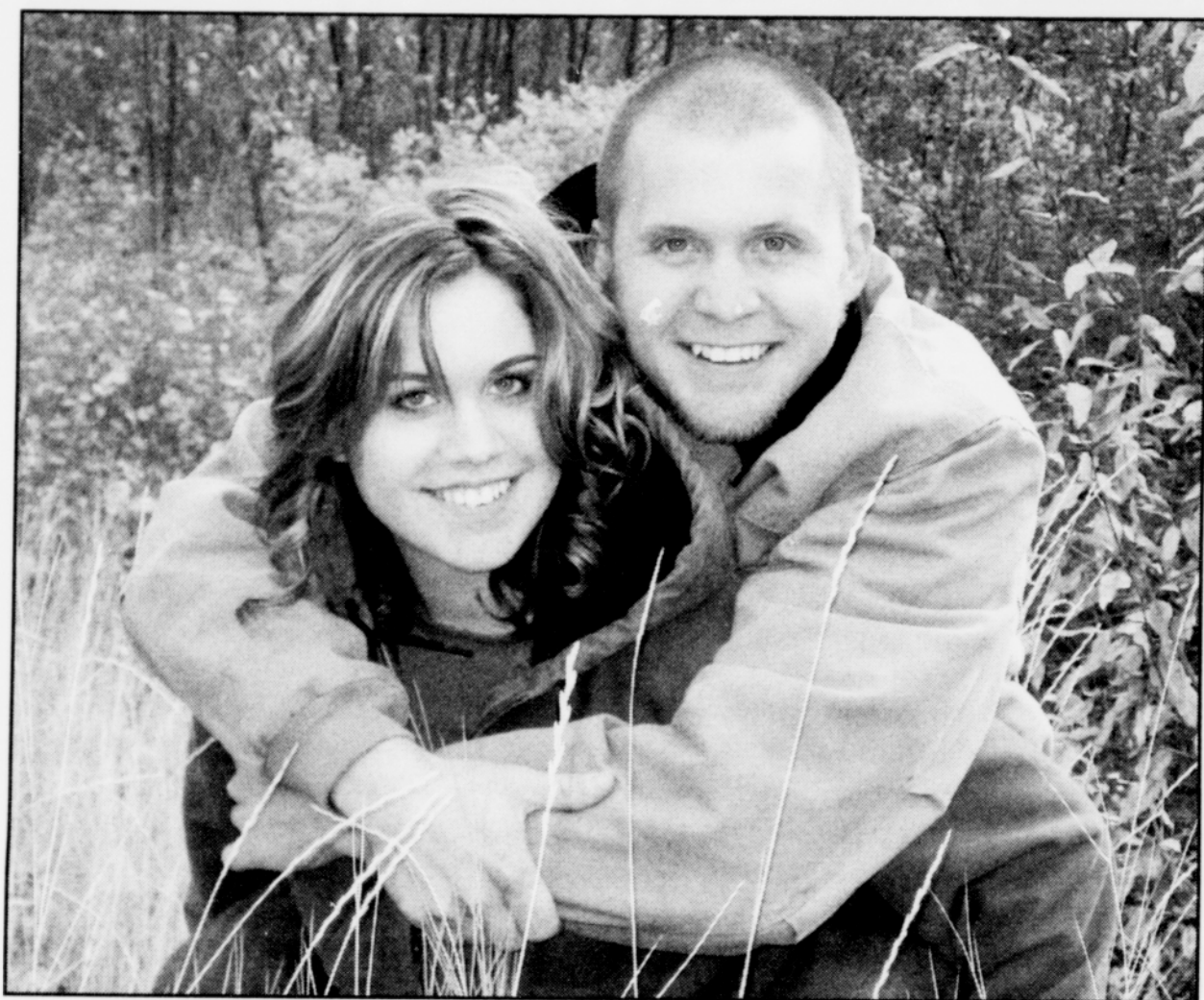

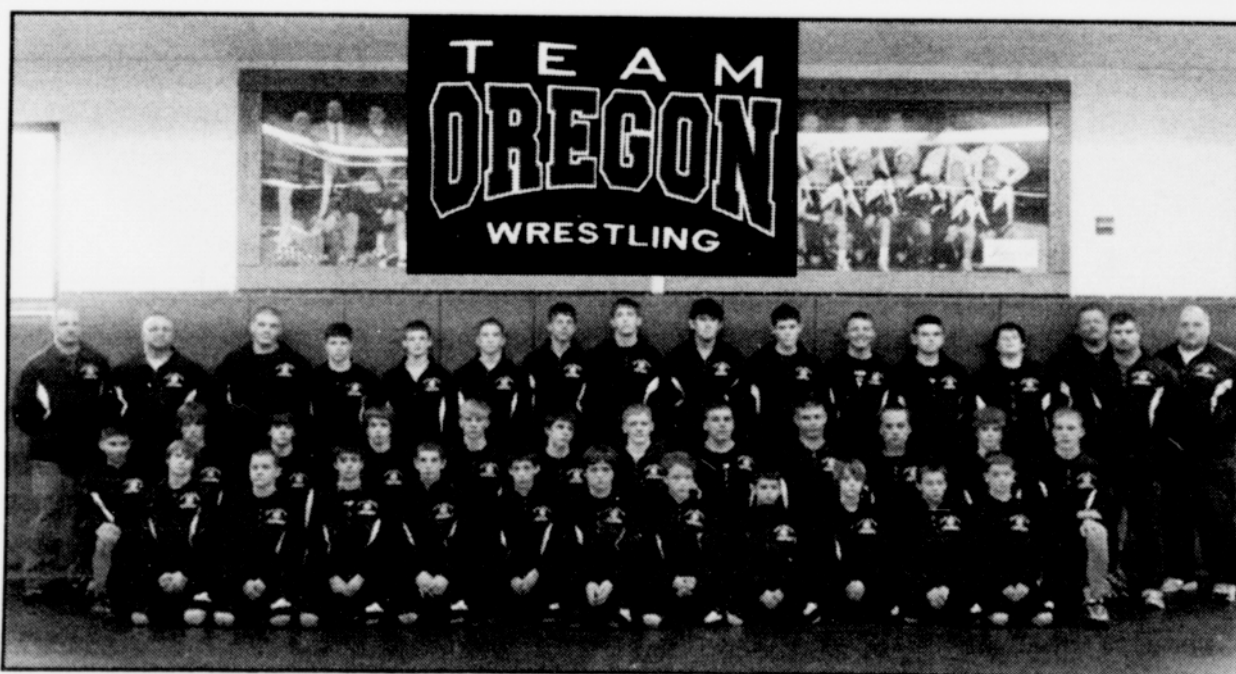
Lee Butler and Tony Blomstrom for all the years of coaching me and helping me be a better wrestler," said Daniel.

Besides being healthier, liking exercise and making diet changes, Daniel has "more commitment to the sport, more

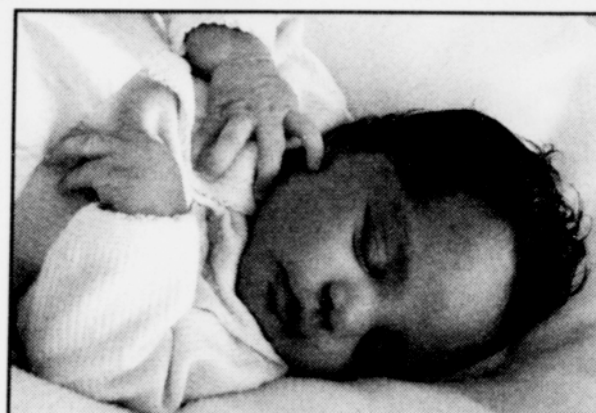
respect for himself and others, and he has shared that he is so happy to have had this experience with the team," says proud mother Delina John.
