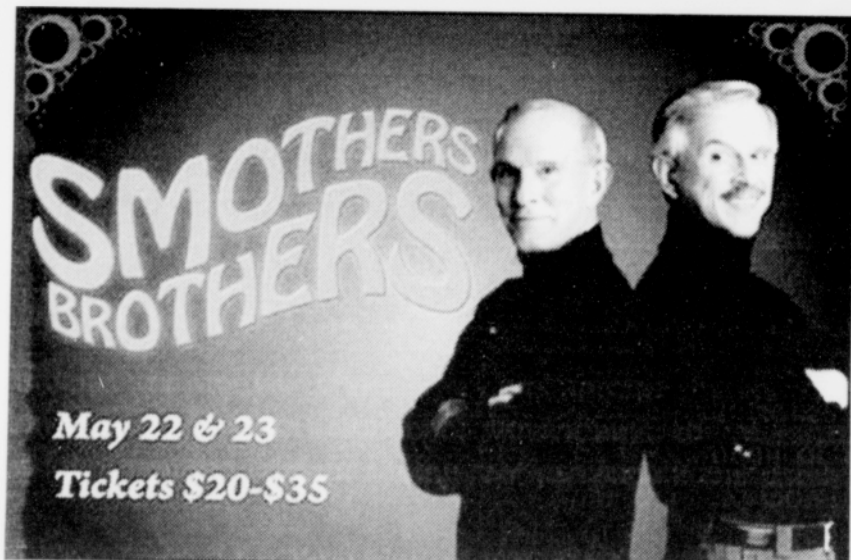

See The Smothers Brothers and Their Time-Honored Comedy



The Smothers Brothers will perform their slapstick style of comedy on May 22-23 at Chinook Winds.

As one of comedy's most famous duos, Tom and Dick have been entertaining crowds for more than 49 years. The Smothers Brothers are being saluted as time-honored legends whose lengthy career has surpassed all other comedy teams in history.

The Smothers Brothers' first professional appearance was at The Purple Onion in San Francisco in 1958 and their first national television appearance was on the Jack Paar show on Jan. 28, 1961.

More than four decades of audiences have seen the Smothers Brothers in their own primetime comedy series in the 1960s, 1970s and 1980s; guest appearances on numerous television programs; countless engagements as headliners in Las Vegas, Reno and Lake Tahoe; a hot-selling video; and 12 top-selling albums as well as continuous coast-to-coast concert tours, some with symphony orchestras.

The contributions Tom and Dick have made to the entertainment world throughout their careers are so highly respected that the Museum of Television and Radio in New York produced a retrospective and seminar on their work, an honor not lightly accorded.

On the other coast, Hollywood ceremoniously distinguished them with one of its most valuable awards – a star on the noted Hollywood Walk of Fame. *The Smothers Brothers Comedy Hour* is now studied in universities across the country as an important factor in the revolutionary changes undergone in the United States during the 1960s.

Sha Na Na Captures Rock Nostalgia

The nostalgic rock group of the '70s Sha Na Na will perform live at Chinook Winds on May 8-9.

Sha Na Na's story is an all-encompassing one. The group was in the original Woodstock Festival lineup, starred in *Grease* (the most successful movie musical), hosted the *Sha Na Na* TV series for four years and still plays more than 50 concerts a year.

From state fairs, performing art centers, casino showrooms to mega-corporate functions worldwide, Sha Na Na is still going strong.

The group taped 97 episodes of the *Sha Na Na* music variety show from 1977 to 1981 that were – and still can be – seen in worldwide syndication. The shows, which featured Sha Na Na's music plus the group in comedy skits with special guests – further established its credentials as part of the landscape of rock-'n'-roll America.

Grease: The Movie became another significant building block in the Sha Na Na story. The group appeared in the 1979 musical as Johnny Casino and the Gamblers and contributed to the original music score with six Sha Na Na versions of rock classics and one original song, *Sandy*, co-written by Screamin' Scott Simon for John Travolta to sing.

Show time is 8 p.m. Tickets range from \$10 to \$20.
