A celebration with their family and friends was held in May.

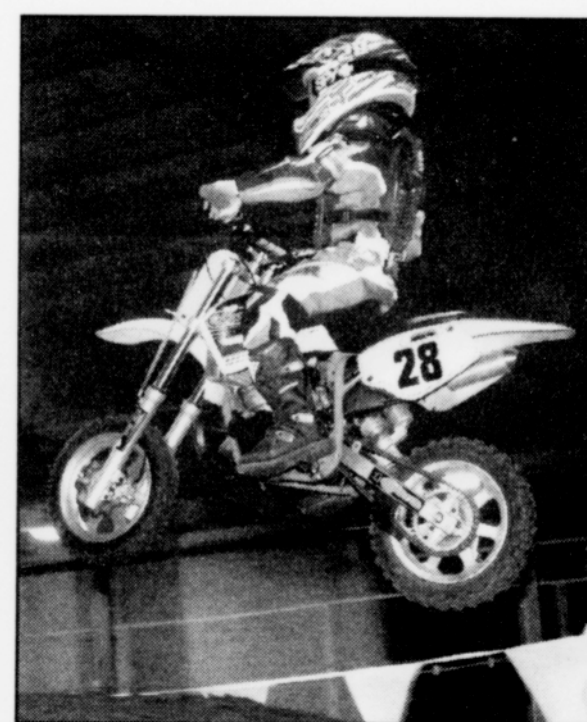
### Graduates!
