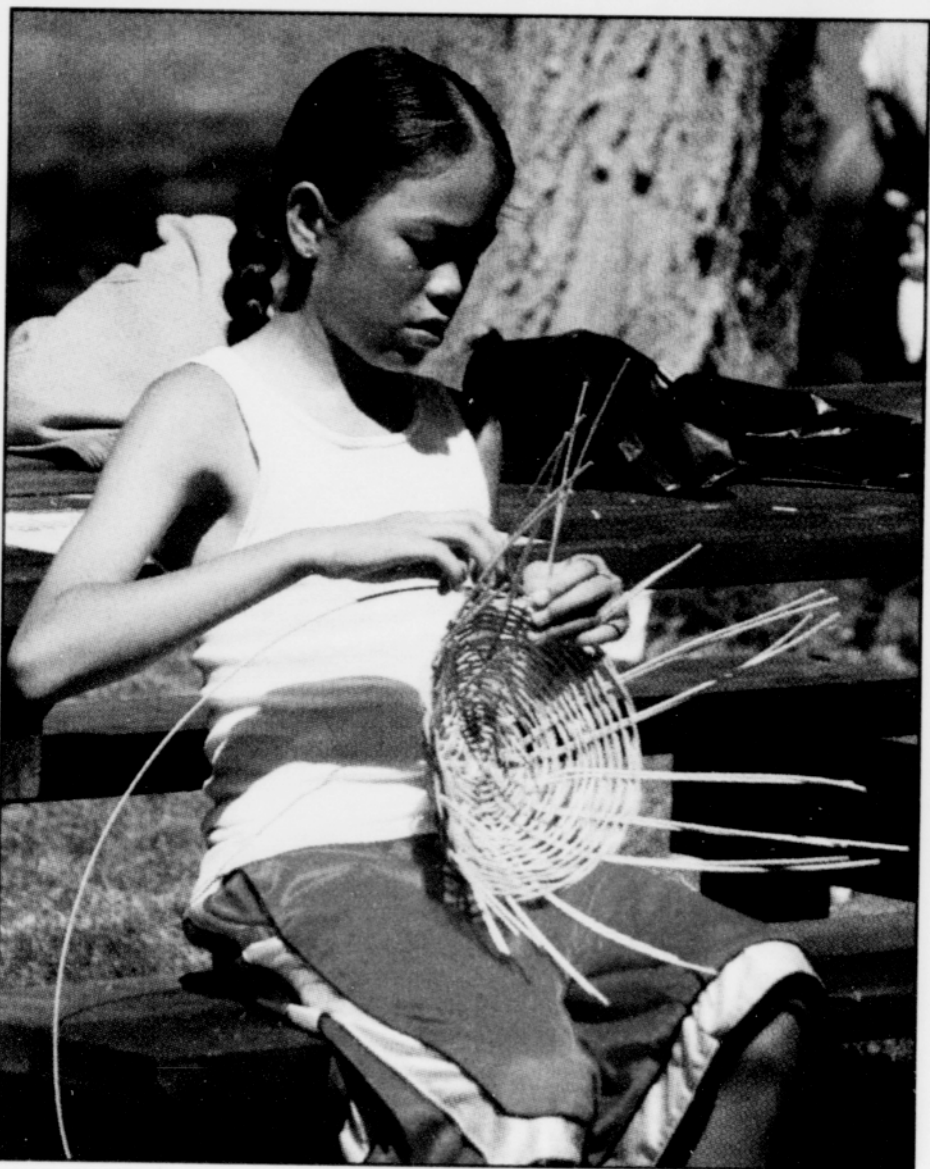

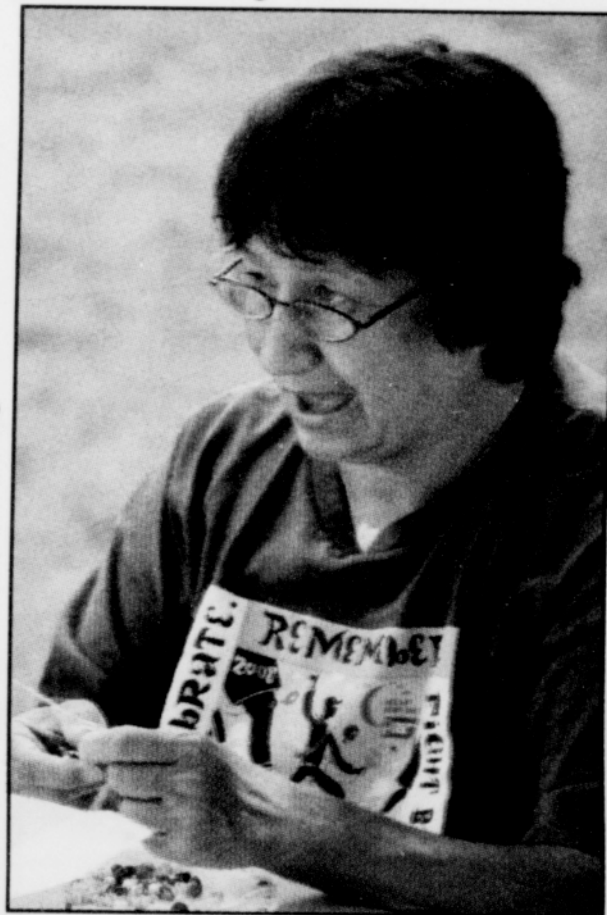
Also, thank you to all of the TYEE workers for all of the food they helped prepare and served to the Elders. Thanks to all of the staff for their assistance.
