

Comedy on the Coast Features John Henton, Two Others

John Henton headlines an amazing night of comedy along with Paul Gilmartin and Lisa Alvarado at Chinook Winds on Sept. 25-26.

Born and raised in Cleveland, John Henton never entertained the thought of a career in comedy. In 1982, while working during the day and studying computer science at night, Henton was urged by a co-worker to try his jokes at a local comedy club's amateur night. He won the amateur night contest and began standup part time.

Henton won the Johnny Walker National Comedy Search in 1991 where he was booked for an appearance by a comedy executive for *The Tonight Show with Johnny Carson*. That was the break he needed to jump-start his career.

Since then, Henton has made appearances on *The Arsenio Hall Show* and *Bob Hope's Young Comedian's Special* as well as returning to *The Tonight Show with Jay Leno*. In 1993, Henton starred in his own half-hour comedy special for Showtime, *John Henton: Comedy With An Attitude*.

Henton is best known for his portrayal of Overton 'Obie' Wakefield Jones on the sitcom *Living Single* and as Milsap 'Sap' Morris on the sitcom *The Hughleys*.

Paul Gilmartin currently can be seen co-hosting movies and cooking every Friday night on TBS' *Dinner and a Movie*, which he has been doing since 1995. As a standup comic, he has dozens of television appearances, including NBC's *Late Friday*, CBS' *The Late Late Show with Craig Ferguson*, and his own half-hour *Comedy Central Presents: Paul Gilmartin*.

He has performed as a standup and a sketch actor at the Montreal Comedy Festival and three times at the Aspen Comedy Festival, most recently as his character, Republican Representative. He has been a guest on *Politically Incorrect* and written for the Emmy Awards as well as Dennis Miller.

Lisa Alvarado has transformed her unique life experiences as a single parent into a hilarious comedy routine. Her natural charisma on stage, beauty and sense of humor make her the complete package.

Born in Chicago to Peruvian parents, Alvarado knew she wanted to be a standup comedian at an early age. She writes all her own material and enjoys teaching and writing for other standup comedians. She currently performs in top clubs nationally, colleges and corporate shows.

Alvarado's TV appearances include NBC's *Last Comic Standing*, Nick at Nite's *The Search for the Funniest Mom in America 2*, SiTV and *Que Loco Comedy*.
