

Start the New Year with Four Entertainers at Best of Comedy on the Coast

Kenny Bob Davis and three other comedians kick off the 2010 comedy season at Chinook Winds with Best of Comedy on the Coast, set for Jan. 1-2.

Davis is the co-creator and producer of Comedy on the Coast. He began as a '60s guitar-playing folk singer, playing bars and at the beach.

In 1978, Davis opened as a solo comedian for Eddie Rabbitt and since then has opened many concerts for such legendary stars as George Burns, Willie Nelson, Kenny Rogers, Vince Gill and Larry Gatlin.

He has headlined all over the United States as a solo standup comedian or a one-man corporate showman and is a USO performer for our military aboard several aircraft carriers at sea and for our Marines in the field (he is a veteran, a USMC corpsman).

Larry Gatlin opened many doors for Davis into celebrity and pro golf events, where Davis became known as "The Golf Comic" in 1980. He has performed at or played in more than 300 charity and PGA/LPGA tour events.

You've also seen him as an actor on *Gremlins*, *ER*, *Zach and Cody*, *Sisters* and *Murder She Wrote*.

Davis just released his fourth live album, *A Vegas Souvenir*. He is still going strong in all areas and is a total package for any stage event.

Michael Finney began as a magician bartender at the Golden Eagle Restaurant in Phoenix, Ariz. In 1986, he was a finalist on *Star Search with Ed McMahon* and in 1987 he received the Silver Lions Head from Siegfried & Roy for comedy and magic.

Finney continued to work comedy clubs across the United States up to 40 weeks a year. He made six appearances on Fox's *Comic Strip Live*, HBO's *Comic on the Road*, *Sunday Comics* with Lenny Clark, Bud Friedman's *Evening at the Improv* and two NBC specials hosted by John Ritter, *World's Greatest Magic* and *World's Wildest Magic*.

Finney also was invited to perform at the inauguration of President Bush in January 2001.

Between his many TV appearances (NBC's *Last Comic Standing*, Comedy Central, MTV) or hosting star-studded red carpet events, Brian Sheil is busy producing and hosting *West Coast Comedy* for National Lampoon and Time Warner on Demand.

Sheil also is the driving force for *The New Rascals Comedy Hour* on XM Satellite Radio and also can be seen on Microsoft MSN video downloads, Windows Media Entertainment page, TV NET and Smart Video Mobile Television.

At 3 feet 6 inches tall, Tanya Davis is the Ferrari of comedy – low to the ground and kind of racy.

She started doing stand-up-on-a-chair in 1990 after a brief but disappointing NBA career. Today she has brought comedy to new heights, headlining clubs and colleges throughout the world.

Tanyalee has made a small, yet significant dent in the entertainment scene thus far. What she lacks in height she makes up in tenacity. Known as "the little lady with a lot of big laughs," Tanyalee's

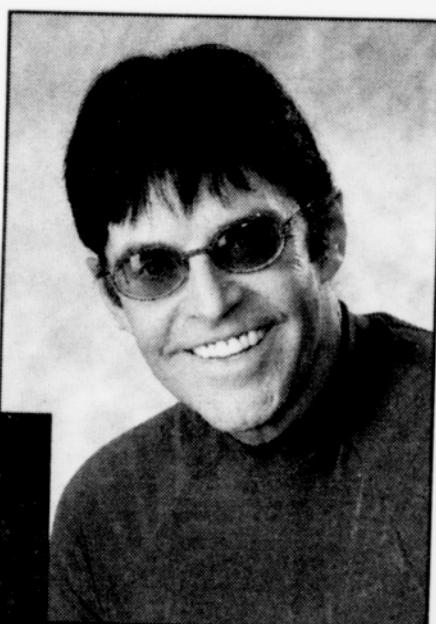
Steppin' Stone, *Pleasant Valley Sunday*, *Indian Reservation, Arizona*, *Kicks* and *Hungry*.

Show time is 8 p.m. Tickets range from \$25 to \$40.

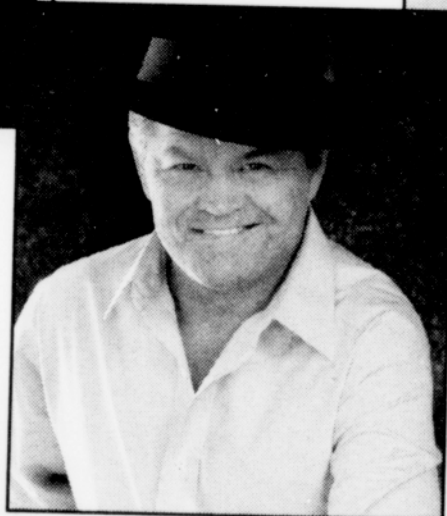

11th Annual Fantasy of Trees and Angels Ball Ring in Holiday Season

Each year, Angels Anonymous, a local non-profit charitable organization, presents "The Fantasy of Trees" and "The Song of the Angels" Holiday Ball, the group's biggest annual fund-raiser, at Chinook Winds Casino Resort. This year's event will be held Dec. 2-5.

The decorating of the Christmas trees will begin Dec. 1 at noon. Sponsors have until noon the following day to finish their trees and have them ready for viewing.

The viewing of the trees will commence at noon on Dec. 2 and will continue through Dec. 5, concluding with the auction that evening at the Holiday Ball.

In addition to the auctioning of trees, there will be numerous drawings, special auction items, gingerbread houses to bid on and gift boxes for sale with secret surprises donated by local merchants.

Bring the whole family to view this wonderland of the Christmas season featuring exceptional trees decorated beyond imagination. There is no admission fee.

The Angels Ball takes place on the evening of Dec. 5. You'll want to dress up in your festive best for this elegant evening on the town.

Michael Dane will provide music during the dinner hour, followed by dancing to the sounds of the Party Angels.

Seating is limited for this event, which is not only considered by many as the most enjoyable event of the holiday season, but one that celebrates the true meaning of Christmas – providing a means to help those who are in need. Hours of the ball are 5:30 p.m. until midnight.
