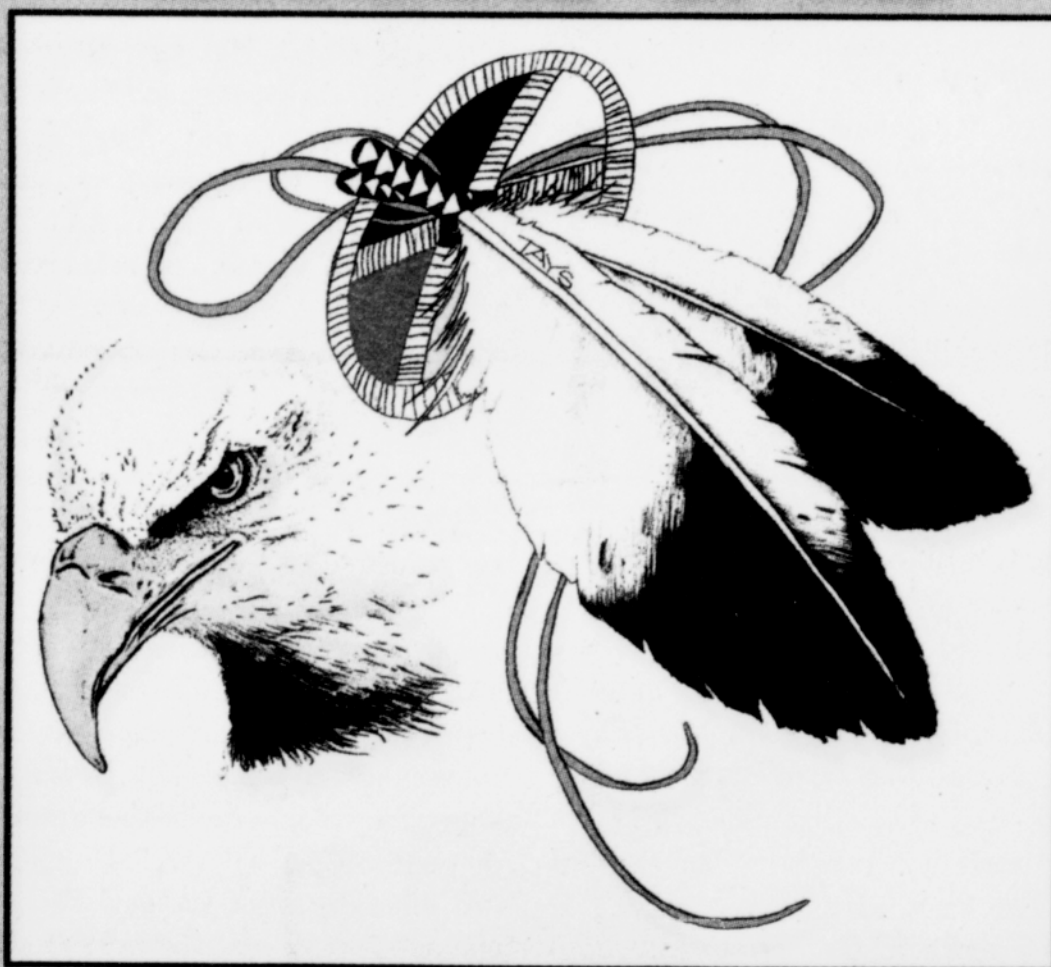

The Assessment and the NPS Management Plan were prepared for CTSI by Earth Design Consultants, Inc.
