## STATE OF OREGON PROCLAMATION OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR

**WHEREAS:** The battleground that was Korea in the years 1950 to 1953 tested the resolve, courage, and commitment of an America barely five years beyond the tremendous sacrifices of World War II; and

**WHEREAS:** Nearly 390,000 American service men and women who served there suffered bitter winters that would claim casualties approaching those inflicted by guns, shrapnel, and bayonets; and

**WHEREAS:** In 38 months of intense fighting, 33,000 Americans gave their lives fighting for democracy, including 269 Oregonians; and

**WHEREAS:** When the guns were silenced on the Korean peninsula, it marked the world's first determined stand against Communist aggression; and

**WHEREAS:** The Korean War has often been called the "Forgotten War," but those who served our country during the conflict should never be forgotten; and

**WHEREAS:** Friday, June 25, 2010, marks the 60th anniversary of the Korean War.

**NOW,**  
**THEREFORE:** I, Theodore R. Kulongoski, Governor of the State of Oregon, hereby proclaim **June 25, 2010** to be
