

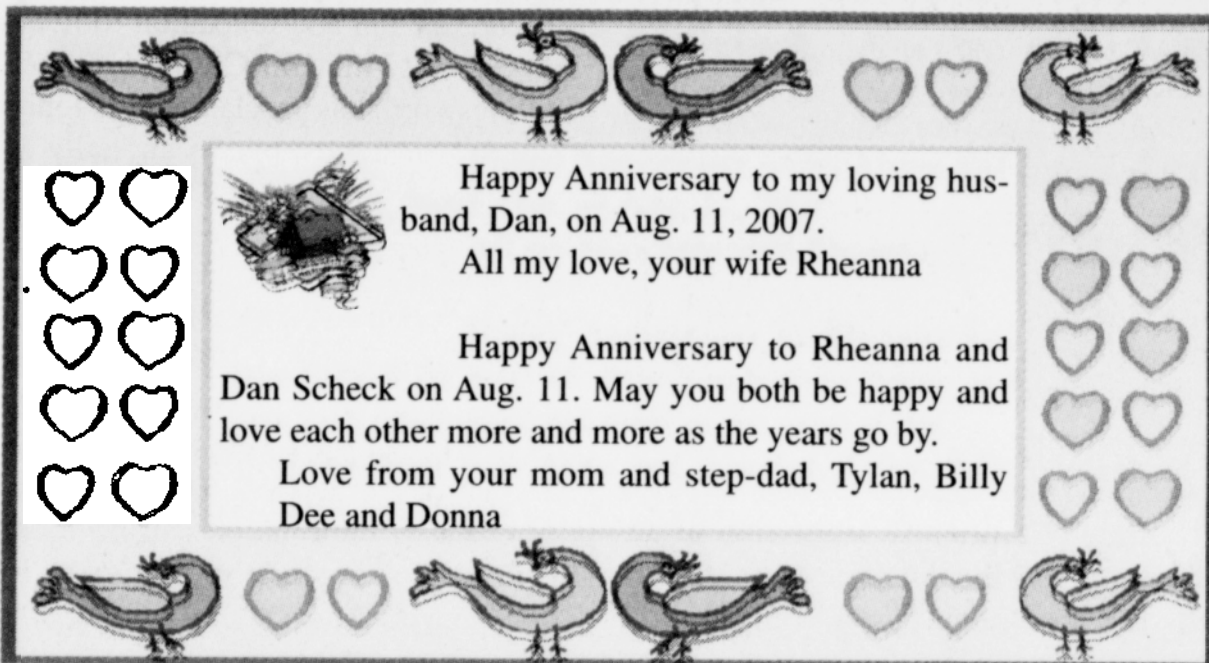


Just wanted to say I hope you both have a great time at college! Good luck and remember we love you. On to the next phase ... love you both very much.
