Sorry, no recipe this month. I felt it necessary to more clearly define the cities we serve within our 15-county service area.

The counties we serve include Lincoln, Yamhill, Polk, Marion, Linn, Benton, Lane, Douglas, Coos, Tillamook, Clatsop, Columbia, Multnomah, Washington and Clackamas.

Some of the counties we serve are designated as rural only. This means we only serve cities/towns with a population of 10,000 or less. The counties designated as rural only are Multnomah, Clackamas, Washington, Coos, Douglas, Clatsop and Columbia.

I have checked the Oregon cities census information to see which cities in the rural-only counties would be in our service area. They are:

- Multnomah County: Fairview, Maywood Park and Wood Village
- Clackamas County: Barlow, Damascus, Johnson City, Molalla, Rivergrove, Sandy and Scappoose
- Washington County: Banks, Durham, Gaston, King City, North Plains and Rivergrove
- Coos County: Bandon, Coquille, Lakeside, Myrtle Point, North Bend and Powers
- Douglas County: Canyonville, Drain, Elkton, Glendale, Myrtle Creek, Oakland, Reedsport, Riddle, Sutherlin, Winston and Yoncalla
- Clatsop County: Astoria, Cannon Beach, Gearhart, Seaside and Warrenton
- Columbia County: Clatskanie, Columbia, Estacada, Prescott, Rainier and Vernonia

I tried to get all the eligible cities on this list, but if you live in one of these counties and you think you might be eligible, contact your city government and find out the population.
