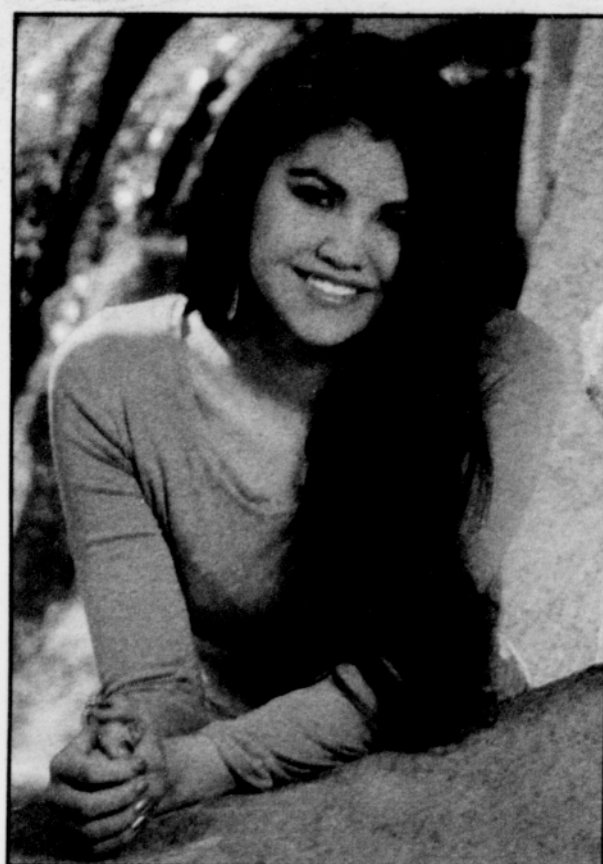


**Kevin Goodell

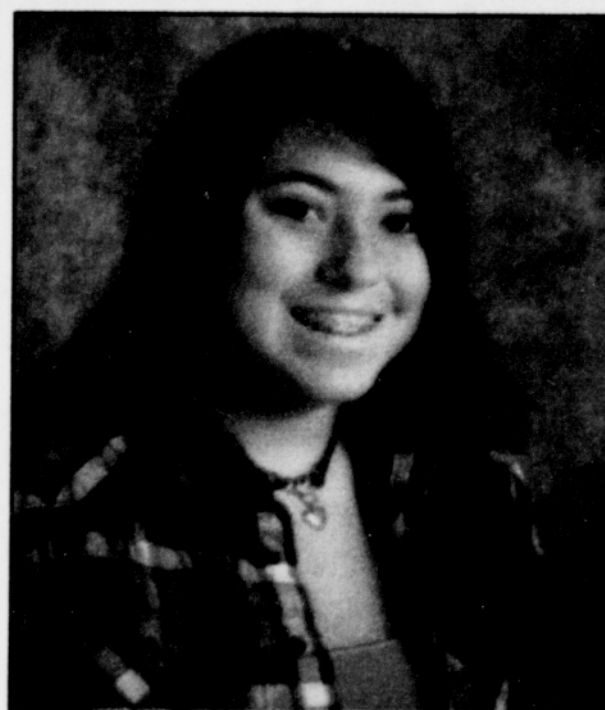
