Comedy on the Coast rings in laughs

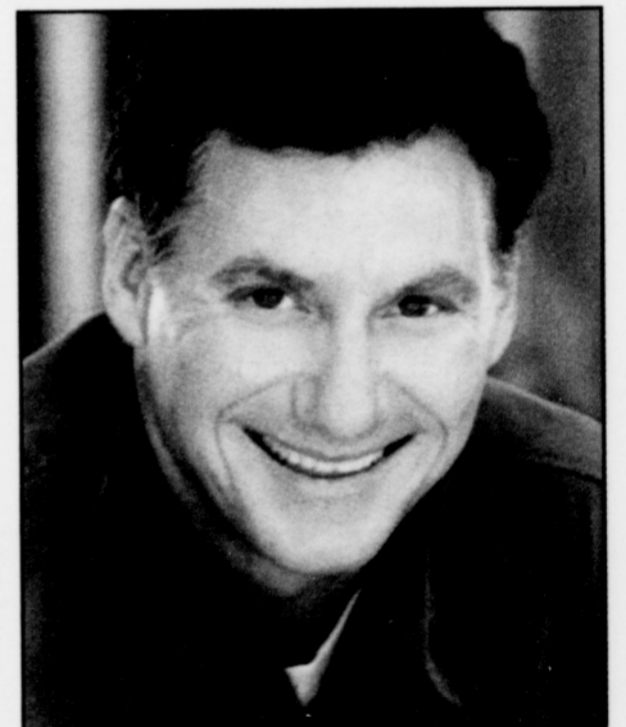
John Caponera headlines Comedy on the Coast on Sept. 9-10 and is accompanied by Carrie Snow and Lang Parker for two nights of laughter.

Caponera worked the Chicago comedy club circuit for the first two years of his career and then took his act on the road. He developed it over a 17-year career of performing for audiences all over the world.

Caponera is considered a comic's comic, a true professional offering a mix of material from topical to impressions to characterizations to stories and one-liners. Michael Paskevich of the *Las Vegas Review-Journal* writes: "Unafraid of letting a room grow quiet, Caponera sets his own intentionally erratic pace, pausing to perfection to complement his oddly timed but rewarding comic insights. The jokes are further bolstered by his talent for facial gestures that range from goofy to arrogant, making Caponera arguably the hottest club headliner going at present."

Snow's standup career began after she earned a degree in rhetoric from UC-Berkeley. Her television career includes PBS' *Comedy Tonight* (which she later hosted for two award-winning seasons), *An Evening at the Improv* and guest-starring on multiple talk shows.

Her original *Comedy Tonight* performance was nominated for a local Emmy award. Snow later was hired by Roseanne to write standup and special projects like the *MTV Music Awards* and the monologue and sketches when Roseanne hosted *Saturday Night Live*. This led to three

seasons as a story editor on *Roseanne*, including a guest appearance.

Parker earned her fame on the Emmy-nominated NBC show *Last Comic Standing*. She impressed the judges when she came out in her rough tomboy attire and asked, "Have you ever been mistaken for a lesbian?" Judge Buddy Hackett said to Parker, "You are a star!"

Born and raised in Muskego, Wis., Parker has audiences doubling over with laughter when she describes how hard it is for a backwoods girl to be feminine – "Yeah, I played with Barbie. I strung her from a willow tree and shot at her with a BB gun."

Show time is 8 p.m. for this age-21-and-older event. Doors open at 7:30 p.m. with a no-host bar. Tickets are \$15.
