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

Deadline for statements and photos is Dec. 21, 2011, at 4 p.m. Candidate statements must be no longer than 750 words and must not be derogatory or contain personal attacks on any one individual. Statements and photos will appear in the voter's pamphlet. Photos will be included on the ballot. Mail your statement and photo to:

2012 TRIBAL ELECTION INFORMATION

New Signature Card

The Siletz Tribal Council has approved a new signature card along with revisions to the Election Ordinance regarding the process of verifying the new signature cards. The significant change includes new verification options that can reduce the involvement of the Enrollment Department in the signature verification process.

The new verification process provides Tribal members the opportunity to have their signature notarized or provide a copy of current identification with name, address and signature to verify the signature card. If neither of those options is available, the Enrollment Department will still assist in verifying signatures with documentation on file.

The new signature cards have been mailed to all Tribal members 18 and over. With the election just a few months away, it is very important that the new signature card be returned as soon as possible.
