Dear Siletz Tribal Voting Member:

The Election Board apologizes for the recently mailed letter outlining incorrect dates for updating your signature card. The Siletz Tribal Council approved a new signature card and revisions to the Election Ordinance. The significant change includes new verification options which can reduce the involvement of the Enrollment Department in the signature verification process.

The new verification process provides Tribal members the opportunity to have their signature notarized or provide a copy of current identification with name, address and signature to verify the signature card. If neither of those options is available, the Enrollment Department will still assist in verifying signatures with documentation on file.

If you have a current signature card on file, you are still eligible to vote – you do not have to take any action.

If you choose to update your signature card, you may choose the option that is best for you. Please complete and return to the Election Board by Dec. 30, 2011, to ensure your current signature is verified in time for the 2012 Election.

The revised Election Ordinance is available online at ctsi.nsn.us, select Government Operations then Tribal Ordinances. A new signature card is posted on the Election Board website under "Members Only."
