The following recipe is from Pamela Barlow-Lind in the Tribal Planning Department, who took fifth place in our recipe contest.

## Easy Apple Cake

20 servings. Prep: 25 min.  
Bake: 35 min. + cooling

### Ingredients

1¾ cups sugar  
1 cup vegetable oil\*  
3 eggs \* (powdered eggs)  
1 teaspoon vanilla extract  
2 cups all-purpose flour\*  
¼ teaspoons baking powder

1 teaspoon salt  
1 teaspoon ground cinnamon  
¼ teaspoon baking soda  
2 cups finely chopped peeled tart apples\*  
1 cup chopped walnuts (optional)  
¼ cups whipped topping  
\* commodity product

### Directions

In a large bowl, beat the sugar, oil, eggs and vanilla until well-blended. Combine the flour, baking powder, salt, cinnamon and baking soda; gradually beat into sugar mixture until blended. Fold in apples and walnuts.

Transfer to a greased 13-by-9-inch baking dish. Bake at 350° for 35-45 minutes or until a toothpick inserted near the center comes out clean. Cool on a wire rack. Serve with whipped topping. Yield: 20 servings.
